CHANDIGARH: Former Punjab Chief Minister Capt Amarinder Singh today rued the scrapping of the Mattewara Textile Park project, terming it as the most regressive and short sighted decision. "You don't throw away the baby with the bath water", he remarked in a statement while reacting to the gov-

the park was approved. Capt Amarinder regretted that the Aam Aadmi Party government, after initially deciding to go ahead with the project had scrapped it, just because some people opposed it without any justification or without any technical and scientific knowledge about the environment.

The former Chief Minister said, the Ludhiana Textile Park was one of the seven such parks coming up across the country. This textile park was set up with the specific objective of sustainable industrialization that does not harm the environment according to the United Nations Sustainable Development Goal 9.

He said, with such approach no industrialization can take place in Punjab, which is already scarce of land. "When Punjab is reel ing under such a financial crisis and investments are not coming, such a regressive decision will further discourage the industry from coming here", he observed, while adding, such a crucial decision should not have been taken in such haste.

Moreover, he pointed out, the National Green Tribunal had already set up an expert committee to examine the project and objections raised from certain quarters. He said the government should have waited for its decision.

He also expressed surprise as to how the Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann took a U-turn after supporting the project and even announced funds for further land acquisition.

Three more arrested by SIT probing 1984 anti-Sikh riots in Kanpur



A special investigation team probing the 1984 anti-Sikh riots on Thursday arrested three more people who were allegedly part of a mob that had set houses ablaze here killing several people, an official said.

As many as 127 people were killed in the riots in Kanpur. The special investigation team (SIT) was formed by the Uttar Pradesh government three years ago on the orders of the Supreme Court to reinvestigate the cases. The SIT has so far arrested 22 people in connection with the violence that occurred following the assassination of then prime minister Indira Gandhi by her Sikh bodyguards in Delhi on the morning of October 31, 1984. The fresh arrests were made in two cases, one of which was lodged with the Naubasta police and the other

The three arrested have been identified as Chandra Pratap Singh (67), Anil Nigam (61) and Ram Chandra Pal (61) the younger brother of Kailash Pal who was arrested on Tuesday. They were produced before a court, which remanded them in judicial custody for 14 days, said Deputy Inspector General of Police (DIG) Balendu Bhushan Singh, who is heading the SIT.

### WPI inflation eases to 3-month low of 15.18 per cent in June

flation (WPI) eased to a threeon a sharp decline in the prices of minerals, but food articles continued to remain costly.


June is the 15th consecutive month when the Wholesale Price Index (WPI) based inflation remained in double-digit. Last month, it touched a record high of 15.88 per cent. In June

2021, it was 12.07 per cent. Inflation in food articles in June was 14.39 per cent, as prices of vegetables, fruits and potato witnessed a sharp spike

over the year-ago period. In May, the wholesale price inflation in food articles was 12.34 %. The rate of price rise in vegetables was 56.75 per cent. while in potato and fruits, it was  $39.3\hat{8}$  and 20.33 per cent, respectively.

#### Shiv Sena stakes claim for LoP in Maha Legislative Council

After being dislodged from power in Maharashtra, the Shiv Sena has staked claim for the post of leader of opposition in the state Legislative Council.

A delegation of Shiv Sena MLCs - Manisha Kayande, Sachin Ahir, Ambadas Danve, Vilas Potnis and Sunil Shinde met Counil Deputy Chairperson Neelam Gorhe on Monday and submitted a letter staking claim for the post of the LoP and chief whip. The race is between the NCP and the Shiv Sena, amid fears that some of its members may switch sides. The Sharad Pawar-led NCP is just two short of the Sena's tally in the Upper

House of the state legislature. As on July 8, the 78-member Maharashtra Legislative Council has 24 BJP members, 12 of the



Shiv Sena and 10 each of the Congress and NCP. The Lok Bharti, Peasants and Workers Party of India and the Rashtriya Samaj Paksh have one member each. The Council also has four independents, while 15 seats are vacant. The Sena's move comes following a rebellion in the party, which led to its 55 MLAs splitting into two factions. The camp led by Chief Minister Eknath Shinde has the support of 40 MLAs, while 15 have sided with former CM Uddhav Thackeray.

#### India projected to surpass China as world's most populous country during 2023: UN China and India accounted the middle of the century.

India is projected to surpass China as the world's most populous country next year, according to a report by the United Nations on Monday which said that the world population is forecast to reach eight billion by mid-November 2022.

The World Population Prospects 2022 by the United Na-Not married and unconditionaltions Department of Economic and Social Affairs, Population Division, said that the global Sen said in a cryptic Instagram post on Friday, a day after forpopulation is projected to reach eight billion on November 15, 2022. The global population is growing at its slowest rate since 1950, having fallen under one per cent in 2020.

The latest projections by the United Nations suggest that the world's population could grow to around 8.5 billion in 2030 and 9.7 billion in 2050.

It is projected to reach a peak of around 10.4 billion people during the 2080s and to remain photograph with her daughters,

"Disparate population growth rates among the world's largest countries will change their ranking by size: for example, India is projected to surpass China as the world's most populous country in 2023, the report said. According to the report, In-

dia's population stands at 1.412 billion in 2022, compared to China's 1.426 billion. India, which will surpass Chi-

na as the world's most populous nation by 2023, is projected to have a population of 1.668 billion in 2050, way ahead of China's 1.317 billion people by

The report added that it is

estimated that ten countries experienced a net outflow of more than 1 million migrants between 2010 and 2021. In many of these countries,

these outflows were due to temporary labour movements, such as for Pakistan (net outflow of -16.5 million during 2010-2021), India (-3.5 million), Bangladesh (-2.9 million), Nepal (-1.6 million) and Sri Lanka (-1 million). In other countries, including

the Syrian Arab Republic (-4.6 million), Venezuela (Bolivarian Republic of) (-4.8 million), and Myanmar (-1 million), insecurity and conflicts have driven the net outflow of migrants over the decade.

#### **Auction of 15 mineral** blocks quashed

Auction of 15 mineral blocks has been quashed in the ongoing financial year, while 32 mines have been put on sale successfully. Of the mines whose auction is annulled, five each are limestone and manganese blocks, two each are bauxite and phosphorite blocks and one is a gold mine.

On the st of mineral blocks in FY23 as on June 7, 2022, the mines ministry said 11 are in Madhya Pradesh and two each are in Chhattisgarh and Uttar Pradesh. However, no reasons were given for the annulment of the auction of the 15 blocks. Of the 32 blocks auctioned, 10 are manganese, eight are limestone, seven are iron ore, five are bauxite and one each is graphite and phosphorite. Total 10 mineral blocks were auctioned in Madhya Pradesh, eight in Andhra Pradesh, four each in Chhattisgarh and Karnataka. two each in Maharashtra and Odisha and one each in Rajasthan and Uttar Pradesh.

## Fretting about current account deficit justified

ndia's Finance Ministry is sanguine about India's economic recovery and has asserted that major macroeconomic risks have subsided over ■ the past six weeks. The Government's cautious optimism is tinged with impending concerns of a speedier tightening of monetary policies by the U.S. Federal Reserve and the resultant dip in asset markets, which can mar sentiment and consumption, on top of persistent geopolitical strife. But for now, interest rate hikes and measures to curtail the outflow of dollars announced by the central bank, with several steps from the government such as the imposition of windfall taxes and higher import duties on forex-drainers like gold, have been credited for lifting some of the dark clouds over the economy. Despite excise duty cuts on petrol and diesel, the Ministry believes India's fiscal math for the year will not unravel thanks to the recent tax levies, and healthy Goods and Services Tax collections (that could get healthier as some GST rate hikes kick in from Monday). Industrial metal prices slipping to 16-month lows, prices for some food items falling off their peaks and crude oil prices descending in the face of fears of a recession in many developed nations, have helped. However, if these fears do not translate into 'a sustained and meaningful' drop in food and energy prices, India's current account deficit will deteriorate in 2022-23 on account of costlier imports and tepid exports on the merchandise account, the Ministry has cautioned. India's high import dependence for fuel means oil price trajectories affect most macro parameters, including inflation, growth, current account balances, fiscal management and the rupee. And economic policymakers are rightfully concerned about the current account deficit (CAD) widening sharply from the 1.2% of GDP last year. There is a vicious circle at

## Dealing with online hate factory

e recent ferocious attack on a judge of the Supreme Court of India by the IT cell of a prominent national political party has given the impression that there are a significant number of people opposed to the scathing judicial criticism of the former national spokesperson of the Bharatiya Janata Party, Nupur Sharma, for her remarks on the Prophet. Rather, it may well be that an overwhelming part of all religious communities would feel a sense of pride that a person of his standing would stand up to the tyranny of groups engaging in hate speech.

#### Pertinent questions

The criticism delivered from the Bench for the first time showed that some judges indeed have a spine and are capable of speaking the truth to power. Particularly at this time when Government interference with the judiciary is at its height (with transfers and supersessions of independent-minded judges), the pungent and fully justified remarks of the judge were like a fresh wind blowing through the country and the judiciary, and boosted the confidence of judges to stand up to executive excesses.

Equally important, the events of the past few days and the uncouth trolling of the judge raise very important questions relating to the ever-growing tendency by the Government to intimidate the judiciary. The questions that arise are: Who are these groups that attack democratic-minded individuals who speak out against injustice? Does the Government have an underground network which operates as an arm of the Government? And, are they financially supported and ideologically encouraged to engage in hate speech? Finally, what should the judiciary do to stamp out organised hate speech of this kind, whether it be against journalists, political opponents of the Government or the judiciary?

In her book, I am a Troll, Swati Chaturvedi describes Internet trolls as persons who sow discord through inflammatory comments on the



Internet. She traces the growth of this network from the early 2000s and attributes its steep upward curve to the support it received from a senior political leader in Government. 'Rightwing propaganda websites constantly peddle hate tweets and slander journalists. They are backed up by coordinated hashtag campaigns where anonymous Twitter handles retweet the same tweet continuously until trending begins'.

She gives instances of tweets of 'gory cow slaughter and imaginary instances of love jihad'. Some of them 'mock women who face sexual abuse and harassment.' They did not spare their own party leader, Maneka Gandhi, when she set up a helpline called '#IAmTrolledHelp'.

A Twitter handle from this group engaged in sustained abuse of a well-known female broadcast journalist. Another hosted a photoshopped picture of a female actor when she joined the Aam Aadmi Party. One of this network asked for 'execution of undertrials without due process saying that the State should not bother to arrest suspects but kill in cold blood'. An extreme episode was when a Congress spokesperson 'was threatened with Nirbhaya-style rape by trolls'. In the context of pellet blinding in Kashmir, there were trolls who called for 'mass murder of Kashmiris, and the dropping of a bomb on a funeral procession'. When journalist Gauri Lankesh was killed in Bengaluru in 2017, a Twitter handle followed by leaders of the party in power tweeted a message that had much profanity. Other journalists were also threatened that they were 'going the Gauri

The Wire reported that a network of 757 Twitter accounts was used to mount attacks against Mohammed Zubair (co-founder of fact-checking website Alt News) and the website, and that the recovery email id for the anonymous Twitter handle was that of a youth leader of the party in power. These accounts revealed sub accounts which exhibited multiple characteristics associated with bot-like and inauthentic behaviour posting more than 500 times a day at all hours of the day'. The purpose was to manipulate public perception about the arrest of Mr. Zubair.

Similar targeting processes were managed by Tek Fog' (a 'sophisticated app used by online operatives to hijack major social media and encrypted messaging platforms'); over eight lakh hostile replies were sent out to tweets by women journalists, of which over five lakh were classified as 'offensive'. The Wire commented that the handlers of 'Tek Fog' are politically aligned and that is why 'India's political elite are operatives 'reached an audience of around eight crore users'. Newslaundry has reported that this well-oiled propaganda machine churned out fake videos and mass tweet links to gear up for Twitter storms'.

Online abuse has often led to actual violence as in the case of the attack on a prominent lawyer by persons who barged into his office. This is not surprising because, as reported by Ms. Chaturvedi, 'office bearers of the party in

power have publicly supported these trolls'. The IT cell of the Government has seen its activity expand with the induction of many volunteers and paid workers. Ms. Chaturvedi has reported that the party in power has 'created a bank of thousands of dormant Twitter accounts' to be used for 'synchronized tweeting' and 'storms'. The party also has 'bots created by the central IT Cell which tweets out identical messages simultaneously' so that they 'look like a real user'. These volunteers and employees 'were given a hit list of mainstream journalists who needed to be constantly attacked'. One of the India's most prominent and respected female journalists was attacked in 'filthy terms' and given 'rape threats'. These volunteers and employees use virtual private networks (VPNs) o 'hide the actual location of the user'.

Going back to the incident of Nupur Sharma in the Supreme Court, it is imperative that the Court understands that the country stands with the judiciary. The hate speech tweets are manufactured by a factory of a political party that produces millions of hate speeches. A criminal investigation by an independent special investigation team of the police is called for. Prosecution must follow. This hate speech manufacturing network must be crushed. This is vital for democracy to survive and for the udiciary not to be intimidated.

## The great omission in the draft disability policy



e Department of Empowerment of Person with Disabilities (DoEPwD) recently released the draft of the national policy for persons with disabilities ("Policy") — public comments have been invited till July 15, 2022 (at: panda.dk@nic.in). The necessity for a new policy which replaces the 2006 policy was felt because of multiple factors such as India's signing of the United Nations Convention on Rights of Persons with Disabilities; enactment of a new disability legislation (Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act 2016) which increased the number of disabilities from seven conditions to 21 and being a party to the Incheon Strategy for Asian and Pacific Decade of Persons with Disabilities, 2013-2022 ("Incheon commitment"). The last epared under the aggis of the United Nations Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific (UNESCAP) which identifies 10 goals for Asia-Pacific countries to ensure the inclusion and the empowerment of persons with disabilities and conformity with the Sustainable Development Goals 2030. These commitments have changed the

discourse around disability by shifting the focus from the individual to society, i.e., from a medical model of disability to a social or human rights model of disability.

The principle of the draft policy is to showcase the Government's commitment to the inclusion and empowerment of persons with disabilities by providing a mechanism that ensures their full participation in society.

In furtherance of this commitment, the policy document highlights a detailed commitment to education, health, skill development and employment, sports and culture, social security, accessibility and other institutional mechanisms. However, a glaring omission is the absence of any commitment to the political

uplift of persons with disabilities. Article 29 of the Convention on Rights of



Persons with Disabilities mandates that state abilities can effectively and fully participate in political and public life on an equal basis with others, directly or through freely chosen representatives...." The Incheon goals also promote participation in political processes and in decision making. The Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act 2016 embodies these principles within its fold. The anti-discrimination commitment under this Act recognises the political domain wherein disabled people should be allowed to realise their human rights and fundamental freedoms. The documents fail to take cognisance of such mandates.

Political empowerment and the inclusion of the disabled are an issue that has not found traction in India's democratic discussion. India does not have any policy commitment that is aimed at enhancing the political participation of disabled people.

The exclusion of disabled people from the political space happens at all levels of the political process in the country, and in different ways. For instance, the inaccessibility of the voting process, barriers to participation in party politics or a lack of representation at

gravated the marginalisation of the disabled. Section 11 of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act prescribes that "The Election Commission of India and the State Election Commissions shall ensure that all polling sta-

the local, State or national levels have all ag-

tions are accessible to persons with disabilities and all materials related to the electoral process are easily understandable by and accessible to them". Although this mandate has been in existence for a few years, the disabled people still report accessibility issues before and on election day. There is often a lack of accessible polling booths in many locations. There is still no widespread adaptation of braille electronic voting machines and even wheelchair services at all polling centres. The Election Commission has developed its own prohandling PwDs during the electoral process.

Political parties in India still do not find the disabled as the large electorate to specifically address their needs.

The lack of live aggregate data on the exact number of the disabled people in every constituency only furthers their marginalisation. The lack of accessible space for party meetings, inaccessible transport for campaigning or an attitudinal barrier among voters and party leaders can be termed as contributing factors. Thus, we seldom see disability being highlighted in the manifestos of parties.

#### Inadequate representation

Representation plays an imperative role in furthering the interests of the marginalised community. Our Constitution makers recognised this when they provided for reservation for Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribes in the legislature. Disabled people are not represented enough at all three levels of governance. The response to a right to information filing by this writer to the Parliamentary Affairs Ministry showed that the Government does

not maintain data on the disability aspect of members. The first visually disabled Member of Parliament in independent India, Sadhan Gupta, hardly finds mention in our political or disability discourse. We have often failed to acknowledge disabled political personalities who have overcome the myriad barriers in India's political space.

However, few States have begun the initiave at local levels to increase participation. For instance, Chhattisgarh started the initiative of nominating at least one disabled person in each panchayat. If a disabled person is not elected then they are nominated as a panchayat member as per changes in the law concerned. This is a step that has increased the participation of the disabled in the political

The goal of the policy document — of inclusiveness and empowerment — cannot be achieved without political inclusion. The policy can follow a four-pronged approach: building the capacity of disabled people's organisations and 'empowering their members through training in the electoral system, government structure, and basic organisational and advocacy skills'; the creation, amendment or removal of legal and regulatory frameworks by lawmakers and election bodies to encourage the political participation of the disabled; inclusion of civil societies to 'conduct domestic election observation or voter education campaigns'; and a framework for political parties to 'conduct a meaningful outreach to persons with disabilities when creating election campaign strategies and developing policy positions'.

## New book focuses on PM Modi's organizational skills



The foreword of the book is written by American academician Walter Andersen, the co-author of 'The RSS: A View to the Inside' (2018) and The Brotherhood in Saffron: The Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh and Hindu Revivalism' (1987).

"... Unlike so many studies of Modi, this is not a book that relies almost exclusively on news reports and quotes that appear in the press. Nor does it have an agenda aimed primarily at condemning or praising," he wrote in his description of the book.

Singh's book is an excellent guide to anyone wanting to know how Prime Minister Modi oversaw both the strategic and tactical aspects of the BJP's growth. Singh points out three basic tactics: one, with the help of full-time workers loaned from the RSS, Modi helped build a superstructure of the BJP organisation. Second, he urged "notables" from outside the Sangh fold to join the party so that they could appeal to a wider audience. Third, once Modi realised people were responding to him, he used his ability to move voters like none other, distilling ideas he had picked up on various assignments for the RSS.

The first two tactics had their detractors. Leaders with a conservative bent of mind, like former BJP president Kushabhau Thakre insisted on roping in only those fully immersed in the RSS organisational culture and not outsiders. Prime Minister Modi, however, persisted with this strategy, says

With commodity prices peaking out, major FMGC players, including Parle Products, Godrej Consumer Products and Dabur expect a recovery in demand in both rural and urban markets going forward aided by price stability.

Moreover, FMCG makers can look forward to better gross margins by the last month of Q2FY23 on a year-on-year basis, as there is a lag of around two months in their inventory coupled with forward contracts, experts say. 

During an investigation pertaining to M/s Oppo Mobiles India Private Limited (hereinafter referred to as 'Oppo India'), a subsidiary company of "Guangdong Oppo Mobile Telecommunications Corporation Ltd", China (hereinafter referred to as 'Oppo China'), the Directorate of Revenue Intelligence (DRI) has detectedCustoms duty evasion of around Rs 4,389 crore. Oppo India is engaged in the business of manufacturing, assembling, wholesale trading, distribution of mobile handsets and accessories thereof, across India. Oppo India deals in various brands of mobile phones, including Oppo, OnePlus and Realme.

During the course of investigation, searches were conducted by DRI at the office premises of Oppo India and residences of its key management employees, which led to the recovery of incriminating evidence indicating wilful mis-declaration in



imported by Oppo India for use in the manufacture of mobile phones. This mis-declaration resulted in wrongful availment of ineligible duty exemption benefits by Oppo India amounting to Rs 2,981 crore. Among others, senior management employees and domestic suppliers of Oppo India were questioned, who in their voluntary statements accepted the submission of wrongful description before the Customs Authorities at the time of import.

Investigation also revealed that Oppo India had remitted made provisions for payment of 'Royalty' and 'Licence Fee' to various multinational companies, including those based in

**DHFL scam case: CBI arrests** 

Ramesh Nawandar from Mumbai on Wednesday in connection with the Rs 34,615-crore bank fraud case involving Dewan Housing Finance Limited (DHFL), officials said. The Central Bureau of In-

vestigation (CBI) conducted searches at Nawandar's premises last week and recovered a large collection of uber-luxury watches worth crores of rupees, including Rolex Oyster Perpetual, Cartier, Omega and

They said these valuable items belonged to former DHFL CMD Kapil Wadhawan and former director of the company Dheerai Wadhawan, who allegedly defrauded banks to the tune of Rs 34.615 crore, making it the biggest such case probed by the agency.

These were allegedly purchased using the proceeds of the scam and kept at Nawandar's premises to evade recovery and seizure by enforcement agencies, the officials said.

It has surfaced during the probe that Nawandar was acting as a conspirator aiding and abetting the Dewans to hide the proceeds of the crime and was in the process to dispose these items of when he was arrested by the agency, they said.

#### Indian rupee edges closer to 80 per US dollar

Indian rupee hit a record low for a fourth straight session as the US dollar continued its relentless rise against other major currencies. Foreign institutional investors continued to dump Indian equities, putting further pressure on the Indian currency. Therupeetoday fell to new low of 79.90, breaching Wednesday's low 79.66. The domestic currency depreciated to close at a record low of 79.62 against the US currency on Wednesday.

The US dollar continued its rise today after hotter-thanexpected US inflation numbers hardened expectations for faster Federal Reserve policy tightening. The safe-haven appeal of US dollar has also been boosted by growing fears of a recession.

Data released on Wednesday showed consumer price index in the US rising to a 41-year high of 9.1% in June on the back of



the supply chain bottlenecks partly caused by the Ukraine war and rising demand. A top Fed official, Atlanta Fed President Raphael Bostic, will be speaking at an event on Friday. After the release of US in-

flation data, some market observers speculate that the Fed could hike borrowing costs a full percentage point at its next meeting this month. re easing slightly. On Friday, US jobs data showed robust numbers, suggesting the world's top economy was withstanding the rate hikes, giving the Fed more room for further increases.

#### SBI raises lending rates by 0.10 pc across tenors

Country's largest lender on Friday said it raised the marginal cost of fund based lending rates by 0.10 per cent across various tenors. The benchmark one-year tenor MCLR (Marginal Cost of Fund based Lending Rates), used for most of the consumer loans such as auto, home and personal, will now be 7.50 per cent, up from the 7.40 per cent previously, the bank said. The tenor-wise MCLRs are

effective from July 15, 2022, it added. Among other tenor loans ranging from overnight to six-month, the MCLRs have been raised in the range of 7.15-7.45 per cent, up by 0.10 per cent each. The two-year and three-year MCLRs will now be priced at 7.70 per cent and 7.80 per cent, respectively.

dent Gotabaya Rajapaksa on Wednesday fled to the Maldives on a military jet, hours before he was supposed to step down in the face of a public revolt against him and his family for mishandling the economy that has bankrupted the country.

Prime Minister Ranil Wickremesinghe has declared a state of emergency in the country and a curfew in the Western province has been imposed as protesters gathered near his office at Flower Road in Colombo. He has also ordered the security forces to arrest people acting in a riotous manner.

President Rajapaksa, 73, left the country along with his wife and two security officers on a military jet, a brief statement from the Sri Lanka Air Force said. "On government request and in terms of powers available to a President under the Constitution, with complete approval from the ministry of defence, the President, his wife and two security officials were provided a Sri Lanka Air Force plane to depart from the Katunayake international airport for the Maldives in the early hours of July 13." the statement said.

The Prime Minister's Office



also confirmed that the President had left the country.

Rajapaksa, who enjoys immunity from prosecution while he is president, fled the country before resigning to avoid the possibility of arrest by the new government. On Saturday, Rajapaksa had announced to step down on Wednesday after thousands of protesters stormed his official residence, blaming him for the unprecedented economic crisis that has brought the country to its knees

He arrived in the capital of the Maldives, Male, at around 03:00 local time (22:00 GMT), BBC reported. He was received by a Maldivian government representative at the Velana airport and taken to an undisclosed

location under police escort, sources said, quoting Maldivian officials. Rajapaksa's escape to the Maldives was negotiated by the Maldivian Majlis (Parliament) Speaker and former

president Mohamed Nasheed,

Male said.

The Maldivian government's argument is that Rajapaksa is still the President of Sri Lanka, and that he hasn't resigned or handed over his powers to a successor. Therefore, if he wanted to travel to the Maldives, it could not have been denied, sources said. Thirteen people accompanied Rajapaksa to the Maldives. They arrived in an AN32 aircraft, according to TV news channels.

quests to land a military aircraft in the Maldives were refused by the Civil Aviation Authority in Maldives, but later landing was authorised on the request of Speaker Nasheed.

Rajapaksa is expected to be in the Maldives on transit before flying to another destination which is yet to be known.

He is likely to send his resignation letter only after reaching his final destination on Wednesday evening, Sri Lanka's The Morning news portal reported, citing highly placed government sources. It is learnt that the Rajapaksa's resignation letter would be sent to Speaker Mahinda Yapa Abeywardena at around 8 pm Sri Lanka time, it added.

Meanwhile, the High Commission of India in Sri Lanka categorically denied "baseless and speculative" media reports that it facilitated the escape of Rajapaksa to the Maldives.

"It is reiterated that India will continue to support the people of Sri Lanka as they seek to realize their aspirations for prosperity and progress through democratic means and values. established democratic institutions and constitutional frame-

As the news of Rajapaksa's departure spread, an enthusiastic crowd gathered in Galle Face Green chanting the popular phrase Aragalayata Jayawewa, or Victory to the struggle in Sinhalese and "Go home Gota".

The Police fired tear gas on protesters who had gathered near the PM office. The protesters broke through a barricade despite tear gas and stormed the prime minister's office, calling for his resignation. Prime Minister Wickremesinghe has already said he was willing to resign and make way for an allparty government to take over. Citing sources, BBC also re-

orted that Rajapaksa's younger brother and former finance minister Basil Rajapaksa has also left the country. Basil, the 71-year-old leader who is being widely held responsible for the country's worst economic crisis which has heaped misery on the people, is a US passport holder.

On Monday night, both Rajapaksa and his brother Basil were turned back at the Colombo airport as they attempted to leave the country amid mounting anger against the powerful family for mishandling the island's worst economic crisis.

Worldwide rising inflation which started with the effects of the pandemic and worsened by the global oil crisis fueled by the Russia-Ukraine war – Europe is taking the brunt of it all. 



### ODI cricket needs to find its relevance: Ashwin

Ace India off-spinner Ravichandran Ashwin believes that ODI cricket needs to find its relevance as the 50-over format is turning out to be an extended form of T20 cricket without "ebbs and flows".

Bilateral ODIs across the globe is fast losing relevance and some like former India head coach Ravi Shastri want more franchise-based T20 leagues than these kind of series.

"It's a question of relevance and I think ODI cricket needs to find its relevance. It needs to find its spot," Ashwin, who has 151 wickets in 113 ODIs, said on the upcoming show of the 'Vaughany and Tuffers Cricket club podcasť.

The podcast is hosted by former England captain Maichael Vaughan and left-arm spinner Phil Tuffnell. "The greatest beauty of one day cricket is sorry was the ebbs and flows of the game. People used to bide their time and take the game deep. The one-day format used to be a format where bowlers had a say," added the 35-year-old.

Ashwin, himself a "cricket nut" admitted that he switched his TV off after a point while watching an ODI game.

"Even me as a cricket badger and a cricket nut, I switch off the TV after a point and that's frankly very scary for the format of the game. When those ebbs and flows go missing, it's not



cricket anymore. It is just an extended form of T20," he maintained. Currently, two new balls are used in an ODI innings but Ashwin pushed for returning to the old format where one was ball used, saying it would then be an even contest.

"I think one ball is something that would work and spinners would come into the game to bowl more at the back end. Reverse swing might come back in, which is crucial for the game," the tweaker, who has 442 Test wickets, added.

Ashwin's comments have come at a time when South Africa decided to withdraw from the ODI series in Australia, which was scheduled to be played in January because of crammed schedule and launch of its domestic T20 competition.
