Cabinet nod to Rs 1.64 lakh cr BSNL revival package

The Union Cabinet on Wednesday approved a Rs 1.64 lakh crore package for the revival of state-owned telecom firm BSNL, Telecom Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw said. The revival measures approved by the Cabinet focus on fresh capital for upgrading services, allocating spectrum, de-stressing its balance sheet and augmenting its fiber network by merging Bharat Broadband Nigam Ltd (BBNL) with BSNL.

Briefing reporters on the decision taken by the Union Cabinet, he said the package has a cash component of Rs 43,964 crore and a non-cash component of Rs 1.2 lakh crore spread over four years. The government will make administrative allocation of spectrum BSNL needs to offer 4G services. The allocation of spectrum in 900/1800 MHz band at the cost of Rs 44,993 crore would be through equity infusion. He said to meet the projected capital expenditure for next four years, the government will fund capex of Rs 22,471 crore for developing 4G technology stack.





During this surveillance, it came to the notice that Army jawan Shantimoy Rana was in constant touch with the Pakistani intelligence handlers through social media. When the activities of the jawan were monitored by the team of Intelligence Jaipur, he was found sharing information of military's strategic significance with the Pak female agent via social media after being honeytrapped and in greed of money. On July 25, Shanti Moy Rana was taken into custody. Mishra said that the accused

jawan was interrogated by various intelligence agencies at the Joint Inquiry Center, Jaipur. During interrogation, he said that he is in the Indian Army since 2018 and was in touch with female Pak agents via WhatsApp chat and WhatsApp audio and video calling for a long time. Govt, biotech firms must act to fight monkeypox

he World Health Organiza-

tion, for the second time in

two years, has declared a viral outbreak to be a Public Health **Emergency of International** Concern (PHEIC). With four cases confirmed in India and around 14,500 cases globally, monkeypox outbreaks have triggered international consternation in a world that is yet to recover from the COVID-19 pandemic. After a split verdict at the International Health Regulations Emergency Committee meeting — on whether monkeypox deserves to be termed a PHEIC — it fell on WHO's Director-General, Dr. Tedros Ghebreyesus, to take a call. A PHEIC is just one step short of a 'pandemic' classification. Following the declaration of COVID-19 as a pandemic on March 11, 2020, WHO had come under criticism for not responding with alacrity on the public health threat that the coronavirus pandemic portended. It had termed the COVID-19 crisis as a PHEIC on January 30, 2020 when global cases were around 7,500, or about half the levels now reported for monkeypox. WHO has recommended that countries step up surveillance, amplify public awareness campaigns, governments work towards not stigmatising the disease, and health infrastructure be primed towards producing diagnostic kits. The experience from the COVID-19 pandemic has shown that governments implement measures to avoid 'panic' but are often opaque and vague with the information necessary to quell it. While it is unclear how the monkeypox outbreak will play out, the government must begin coordinated action with the States to summarise and disseminate the extent of the threat. Related to the eradicated smallpox virus, monkeypox is suspected to have amplified due to reduced immunity against the smallpox virus. Indian labs and biotech companies must step up research and mine their arsenal to prepare adequate defences if the need arises.

0 crore people are given food security for months and now after the end of long agitation of farmers the central govt. is silent about making a law on MSP (Minimum Support Price) and a central minister says that it is not possible to pay MSP. Farmers will be panelized to pay the cost of overproduction and ultimately they are thrown amid free market forces as the market price of food grains is less than MSP. Moreover, they give an argument that If govt. purchases all production on MSP it would cost 17 lakh crore which is half the amount of the union budget. Someone is playing with data. Food production is not a waste which will be thrown or dumped. The government would compensate the farmer only the difference between the market price and MSP, not the whole MSP. Wrong interpretation of the data as according to the whole MSP of the crop creates confusion among common men. Moreover, the farmer is producing to feed the population of the nation. The question arises that if you have enough to eat then why GHI is going down and even ranked below Bangladesh and Pakistan. Indian people know hunger well. A food grain surplus nation cannot rank as low as India in the Global Hunger index. The common myth that we are the huge producers of food grains and export a big amount of food grains may be because we are exporting more and consuming less. The per-capita consumption of grains started declining in 1990 and this trend continued in later two decades and a recovery in 2011 -2020 unfortunately, this decline was not taken seriously as academicians interpret it according to the Lorenge curve that with increasing income a consumer

diversifies his consumption and spends



a lesser amount on the consumption of food grains and more on fruits, nuts and animal products. But in the case of India, this doesn't happen as proven by GHI and malnutrition among children. If demand disappeared or declined for food grains, where did the grain go?. For the last ten years, India has emerged as a big cereal exporter and we are not a food surplus state but consume fewer food grains. There is no authentic surplus food grain in the country. Any surplus visible in the forms of large exports and overflowing FCI stocks can be attributed to the fact that the average Indian was not able to maintain her already low level of grain consumption over the last thirty years. Needless to say, this 'average Indian' is located far away from the glittering lives of the metropolitan cities and invisible from the world of policy-makers. 196 million people are undernourished and malnutrition is the top cause of death and disability. It is clear that food security remains a serious challenge.

India now ranks 101 out of 116 countries in terms of hunger and continues to be in the 'severe' hunger category according to the GHI of 2022. These situations clearly prove that food is not accessible in India. South Asia has the highest child wasting rate of any region, and India is the worst performer. At 17.3%, India's child wasting rate is only slightly better than it was last vear, at 20.8%

MSP is a crucial and key issue for food security and the survival of agriculture as it works as a social safety net for farmers. The unpredictability of agricultural yields and products often results in windfall losses making the lives of farmers debt-ridden and pathetic. The economic decisions involved in agriculture are massive and need to be recognized as such. The demand for Minimum Support Prices (MSP) is directly linked to food security in India. Hence, farmers have a rationale and urgency in seeking govt attention towards their economic well-being as made or marred by new agricultural legislations of the central govt. For instance, students of economics are familiar with the COBWEB theorem. A farmer has to take the decision to produce a particular crop minimum of six months before marketing so then an assurance of minimum support price is a must in agriculture. Every industry can increase or decrease its production according to the demand in the market but a farmer can not as he has sown the crop six months before, it reaches to market and the standard law of demand and supply of Dr Marshall does not work in food production. A farmer never knows what will be market and weather conditions in the coming next 5 to six months. Cobweb theorem describes this dilemma of a farmer. How the market forces and nature play a major role in deciding the price of agriculture products as two third of total land has no irrigation facilities in our country. A farmer can be ruined beause of a lack of demand and low prices. Even plenty of production can also ruin him when the price falls because more production when supply surpasses demand and equilibrium price falls. This is called poverty in prosperity in economics. Even the developed capitalist economies, where the free market supposedly rules, highly subsidize their farming communities. So the assurance of MSP is a must for the crops. Govt gives MSP only for 23 crops and only 6% of the total crop is sold on MSP ecause of loopholes in govt. marketing policies. V SRIDHAR EXPLAINS WHY INTEGRATING TERRESTRIAL 5G NETWORKS WITH LEO SATELLITE NETWORKS IS CRUCIAL

A path to global connectivity



s terrestrial 5G mobile networks are being rolled out across countries, there is a renewed interest in integrating Non-Terrestrial Networks, the primary one being the low latency Low Earth Orbit (LEO) satellite networks (SatNets), as a complement to terrestrial networks. Towards this, Starlink, operated by the Elon Musk-owned SpaceX, and One-Web, promoted by Bharti Global, have launched about 2,500 and 648 LEO satellites respectively at an altitude of about 1,200 km with the objective of promoting global broadband connectivity. There are other players such as Reliance Jio in a joint venture with Luxembourg-based SES and Amazon's Project Kuiper.

There are primarily three main use cases for integrating LEO SatNets with tinuity to provide seamless transition between terrestrial networks and SatNets in case of public safety, disaster management and emergency situations; (ii) service ubiquity to provide 5G services in unserved and underserved areas of the world, thereby bridging the digital divide; (iii) service scalability that utilises the unique capabilities of SatNets in multicasting and broadcasting similar content over a large geographical area. The LEO SatNets can provide service not only to stationary but also to in-motion users.

Integration process

Satellites and terrestrial networks have always been considered two independent ecosystems, and their standardisation efforts have proceeded independent of each other. In view of the above advantages, standard-setting organisations such as the Third Generation Partnership project (3GPP), comprising telcos and equipment manufacturers around the world, started integrating SatNets



in the standardisation process.

As an extension to terrestrial networks, satellites were first mentioned in a deployment scenario of 5G in 3GPP Release 14. This was to provide 5G communication services for areas where terrestrial coverage was not available and also to support services that could be accessed more efficiently through satellite systems, such as broadcasting services and delaytolerant services.

Interestingly, wireless communications through LEO satellites over long distances is proven to be 1.47 times faster than communication over the same distance through terrestrial optic fibre. It is this advantage along with global coverage that provide a strong use case for LEO

SatNets to complement terrestrial optic

Issues to be addressed

This would necessitate addressing issues around frequencies to be allocated for satellite broadband, the methodology of allocation, the relatively higher cost of consumer equipment and the placement and interconnections of SatNets with terrestrial public landline/ mobile

networks at the ground stations. The other major challenge in LEO SatNets is the cost of user terminal and access charges to the end users. A recent research analysing both Starlink and OneWeb concludes that the standalone LEO SatNets have a distinct cost advantage only if the density is less than 0.1 person per square km compared to terrestrial broadband networks. Hence it is to the advantage of LEO SatNet providers to integrate their networks with terrestrial 5G networks to improve the cost economies.

Realising the advantages, the Government, in its National Digital Communications Policy 2018, has indicated a number of areas including the development of an ecosystem for local manufacturing of satellite communication systems and promoting participation of private players for the strengthening of satellite communication infrastructure in the country.

Accordingly, the New Space India Limited (NSIL), a public sector enterprise, was established in 2019 under the administrative control of the Department from a 'supply driven' model to a 'demand driven' model, thereby ensuring optimum utilisation of the space assets. The Department of Space also established in 2020 a new regulatory body named the Indian National Space Promotion and Authorisation Centre (IN-SPACe).

IN-SPACe is intended to provide a level playing field for private companies to use Indian space infrastructure and to promote and guide the private industries in space activities through encouraging policies and a friendly regulatory environment. All these, along with the proposed revisions to the Satellite Communications Policy of the Government, will provide the required fillip to LEO SatNets to become an integral part of the communication infrastructure of the country.





Reserve Bank of India in favour of ban crypto currencies, claims CGST Commissionerate Mumbai West busts to launch own digital currency on Blockchain technology

mala Sitharaman said in the Lok Sabha in reply to a written question that the Reserve Bank of India is in favour of banning cryptocurrencies, it was clear that it is concerned about their destabilising effect on monetary and fiscal stability.

FPIs return to Indian equities, invest Rs 1100 crore in July

The relentless selling by foreign investors appears to have taken a breather as they have turned net buyers so far this month with an investment of nearly Rs 1,100 crore in the Indian equity market.

This comes following a net withdrawal of Rs 50,145 crore from equities in June. This was the highest net outflow since March 2020, when they had pulled out Rs 61,973 crore from equities, data with depositories showed. There has been an exodus of Foreign portfolio investors (FPIs) from Indian equity markets over the last nine months, since October 2021. "Given the headwinds in terms of rising inflation and tightening monetary policy, we expect FPI flows to remain volatile," Shrikant Chouhan, Head -Equity Research (Retail), Kotak Securities, said

According to data with depositories, FPIs invested a net amount of Rs 1,099 crore in Indian equities during July 1-22. They have significantly slowed down their relentless selling and have even



turned buyers for several days this month particularly during the last few days. The declining trend of net outflow over the last few weeks coupled with occasional buying does signify that the net outflow from FPIs have bottomed out. The net inflow was driven by better earnings and decline in commodity prices, Chouhan said. Another factor that helped in net inflow was expectation

of less aggressive rate hike by the US Federal Reserve in its upcoming policy meeting than what was anticipated earlier. This also softens the dollar index, which augurs well for emerging markets like India, Himanshu Srivastava, Associate Director - Manager Research, Morningstar India, said. There is also a reduced possibility of recession in the US or it would be less impactful. In addition to that, the recent corrections in the markets have also provided a good buying opportunity for FPIs, he added.

The framework for the Social Stock Exchange (SSE) has been developed on the basis of the recommendations of a working group and technical group constituted by the regulator. The social stock exchange is a

Rishi Sunak, Liz Truss neck and neck after first TV debate clash

tween former Chancellor Rishi Sunak and Foreign Secretary Liz Truss on Tuesday after the UK's prime ministerial candidates went head-to-head in their first television debate as finalists and clashed fiercely on their economic policies and tax plans.

A snap Opinium poll of who performed best in the BBC debate on Monday night found Sunak just slightly ahead at 39 per cent, compared to Truss at 38 per cent. However, 47 % of Conservative Party voters quizzed thought it was the Foreign Secretary who was the better performer, with 38 per cent preferring Sunak.

Overall, the survey of 1,032 British adults held that voters could not decide between Sunak and Truss, with just one point dividing the pair.

In a reflection of what a general election might throw up, data showed that 41 per cent of Opposition Labour Party voters in the survey thought 42-year-

Thai PM sails through last no-confidence vote ahead of polls



Thai Prime Minister Prayuth Chan-ocha sailed through his fourth and final no-confidence vote in Parliament on Saturday with no surprises, ahead of a general election next year.

The vote came after four days of debate targeting Prayuth and 10 of his Cabinet members for economic mismanagement and their failure to prevent corruption.

All 10 ministers also survived the vote, thanks to the ruling coalition government's majority in Parliament.

Prayuth won 256 confidence votes, with 206 against and nine abstaining. Cholanan Srikaew, head

of the main opposition Pheu Thai Party, said the vote result was disappointing as it didn't reflect public sentiment.

We know we cannot win in the Parliament but we will not lose in the general election, he said.

A retired general, Prayuth has weathered three earlier censure motions since 2020. No targeted Cabinet ministers have ever been ousted by no-confidence voting in Thailand's parliamentary

Prayuth, 68, came to power during a 2014 coup and was later elected in 2019 general elections.

Over the past four days of censure debate, Prayuth was the key target of the opposition parties.

Opposition chief whip Sutin Klungsang said that Prayuth's key failure was economic management.

Prayuth, who is also Defence Minister, was also accused of spying on political dissidents with Pegasus spyware, and of misusing the country's budget.

The opposition also accused Deputy Prime Minister and Health Minister Anutin Charnvirakul of legalising cannabis without proper controls.

Prayuth has defended his government's record, noting that Thailand's economy is stable despite rising energy prices and high inflation.

For the remaining 250 days of the government, I insist that I will do everything to take the country out of the crisis as soon as possible, he said. The government has forecast the economy to expand between 2.5 % and 3.5 % this year, up from 1.6 %

Ukraine pushes to try alleged war crimes as fighting rages



The appeal of Ukraine's first war crimes conviction was adjourned on Monday, as prosecutors keep pushing to hold Russia legally accountable for atrocities even as fighting rages in the south and east of the country.

Thin and subdued, Vadim Shishimarin, a 21-year-old captured Russian soldier who pleaded guilty to killing a civilian and was sentenced in May by a Ukrainian court to life in prison, sat in a glass box in the courtroom as he faced news cameras. The hearing was postponed until July 29 due to his lawyer's ill health. Around Ukraine's capital

region, where Russian forces pulled out four months ago, much of the work of documenting crime scenes and interviewing witnesses has been done. Now a more difficult phase in the search for accountability is underway: Finding those responsible. While conducting searches in the previously occupied region, we regularly find documents, passports and lists with names of participants of the units, with their complete data, including sites of birth and dates of births, Andrii Nebytov, head of the Kyiv regional police, told The Associated Press.

Iraq has filed a complaint to the UN Security Council, requesting an urgent session to discuss a deadly artillery attack this week that Baghdad blames on Turkey, the Foreign Ministry said.

Wednesday's attack on the district of Zakho in Iraq's northern, semi-autonomous Kurdish region killed nine Iraqi tourists, including a child, and wounded 20. Foreign Ministry spokesman Ahmad al-Sahaf said the ministry also recalled Iraq's charg d'affaires from Ankara. Iraq's parliament held a session Satur-

day on the attack, with lawmakers deciding to form a committee to investigate further. Turkey, which has several bases in northern Iraq and often conducts cross-border military operations there, says it's targeting militants from the outlawed Kurdistan Workers Party, or PKK.

The group, declared a terrorist organisation by Turkey and the West, has for decades waged an insurgency against the government in Ankara and maintains hideouts in Iraq's mountainous north.

million people, is under the grip of an unprecedented economic turmoil, leaving millions strug-gling to buy food, medicine, fuel and other essentials The severe foreign exchange

shortage has hampered the import of fuel and other essentials in the country reeling under the worst economic crisis in seven decades. Taking to Twitter on Monday, Wijesekera said a QR system has been introduced as the daily fuel demand cannot be fulfilled.

QR system was introduced since the daily fuel demand cannot be fulfilled. Due to Forex issues, Fuel imports have to be restricted in the next 12 months,



he said. Ceylon Petroleum Corporation (CPC) has never distributed Fuel daily to Every single Fuel Station. Practically not possible even when stocks

are unlimited, he said. With the government hard pressed to pay for fuel imports due to the severe forex crisis, it introduced a fuel pass scheme on Saturday where the issues would be rationed under a limited weekly quantity.

Since June 27 the government has stopped fuel supplies and restricted essential services. In a series of tweets, the min-

ister explained the implementation of the National Fuel Pass.

The National Fuel License QR) will be implemented from July 26 at several CEYPETCO and the Lankan Indian Oil Company (LIOC) petrol stations across the country. This system will be in effect until August 1 with the last digits of the number plate, he said.

Filling stations not equipped or having technical difficulties will follow the last digit system and fuel quota allocation until the technical issues are rectified, he said, adding that 60 per

cent of the locations had already been equipped and tested and will be given a priority in fuel

All petrol station owners of CEYPETCO and LIOC are requested to adopt QR system immediately and distribution will be strictly enforced to fuel stations with the QR facilities by 1st of August. We request the public to register with National Fuel Pass and support the initiative, he said.

Options will be given to users to register multiple vehicles with their business registration by the end of the week and to Government institutes to register. Divisional secretaries will be given access to the platform to register generators, gardening equipment and other equipment, he said.




