# Delhi government to launch anti dust campaign to curb pollution

#### FW CORRESPONDENT New Delhi

The Delhi government will launch a campaign next week to curb dust pollution, one of the major reasons behind air pollution in the national capital in the summer season, Environment Minister Gopal Rai said on Thursday.

He said officials have been asked to inspect construction sites and take action against those violating anti-dust pollution norms. Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal had on Monday launched an action plan to combat air pollution during the summer months with a focus on controlling dust pollution.

The Delhi government already has an action plan to combat air pollution in the winter months. The winter plan focuses on stubble burning, firecracker pollution, and industrial and vehicular emissions.

The summer plan involves the participation of 30 government departments.

NEW DELHI: India's merchandise exports are expected to touch USD 500 billion, while services exports could expand to USD 400 billion in the year ending March 2024, said Ajay Sahai, director general of the Federation of Indian Export Organisations (FIEO) on Wednesday.

"The primary reason for the expected export growth is the strong overseas demand in many markets," sahai said. The exporters association highlighted that despite global headwinds, the exports of goods and services might reach USD 900 billion in the current financial year, up from USD 770 billion in the previous year. While addressing FIEO's Niryat Shree and Niryat Bandhu Awards, union minis-



ter for commerce and industry Piyush Goyal urged exporters to explore new markets, however, in view of the possible impact of war in Ukraine and a global slowdown.

"The times ahead are going to be very, very tough. The situation is only deteriorating from what we saw as happened today in the Ukraine-Russia war, it's going to be very, very challenging in the months and years ahead of us.

killed, terrorist killed in fresh Rajouri encounter

In a fresh encounter that broke out in the woods of Rajouri district in Jammu, one militant has been killed while another is suspected to have been injured.

This follows the killing of five army personnel on Friday morning in the Kandi forest area of the district. The Indian Army, in coordination with JKP & CRPF, had launched a joint operation to track down the militants. "In the ongoing joint operation in Kandi Forest, Rajouri sector by Indian Army in coordination with JKP & CRPF, at 7:am hours the cordon while closing in spotted and pinned down the terrorists," Defence spokesman Lt. Colonel Devender Anand said. 'In the ensuing gunbattle, one terrorist has been neutralized and one terrorist is likely to be injured" The operation has so far resulted in huge recoveries, including one AK56, four magazines of AK, 56 rounds of AK, 1 x 9mm pistol with a mag, three grenades one ammunition pouch. The identity of the neutralized militant is yet to be ascertained. Defence Minister Rajnath Singh, along with Army Chief General Manoj Pandey, is expected to visit Rajouri to assess the ground situation.

The officials said that he is likely to chair a high-level security meeting in Jammu before flying back to Delhi. In the meantime, Northern Army Commander Lt Gen Upendra Dwivedi has reached Rajouri to review the ongoing operation.



They were alleged operating with the help of immigration agents and staff working in passport offices. Those arrested by the police were identified as Sukhjinder alias Sharpi Ghuman, Onkar a resident of village Kaki in Jalandhar district and Prabhjot a resident of Bareilly in U.P. According to police information, as many as 10 persons have been taken into custody by STF so far investigating the case. Information also reveals that the racket had also prepared fake passports of Anmol brother and Sachin nephew of



They have accused the government of trying to hoodwink the OBCs to win their support in the 2024 elections. The government, however, insists that the survey was necessary to obtain the exact data on the OBCs so that steps can be taken to ensure their welfare.

Though unlike UP and Bihar, politics in Odisha has never been dominated by the caste factor there is no denying the political clout of the OBCs . Political parties have been trying to cultivate them for several decades.

The minister for SC&ST, minorities and Backward Classes welfare Jagannath Saraka dismisses the allegations of the opposition as politically motivated. " The opposition may say anything but there is no politics in this. This is an attempt to assess the socio-economic status of the OBCs" he asserted

The fact is that no formal census including the caste details of the population has been carried out in the state since 1931. The state, thus, lacks reliable data on OBCs will cover OBCs residing in and Aadhar cards or voter I who currently enjoys only

cards. The survey will cover 11.25 percent reservation in government jobs. This, however, is considered completely disproportionate to their population in the state. The government has not been able to raise this quota because of a cap of 50 percent on reservations mandated by courts.

However, the Naveen Patnaik-led Biju Janata Dal(BJD) has been demanding removal of 50 percent cap on reservation for quite sometime. In 2021 the party not only reiterated this demand but also demanded a caste-based census. Ruling party leaders say they want the cap to be removed so that the government can provide 27 percent reservation to OBCs who constitute the largest chunk of state's population. " Our demand for removal of the cap on reservations stands. At the same time now we have launched a survey to collect authentic

"However, the Modi government has used this pretext to weaken protections for workers and usurp the Constitutional powers of state governments. There are four fatal flaws in the labour codes which make them antiworker. "First, the codes do not apply to most workers or establishments. For example,

establishments employing less than 300 people can fire workers or close units without permission. Contractors employing fewer than 50 people are exempt from workplace safety laws. Provident Fund, gratu-

ity, insurance and maternity benefits are all unavailable in smaller establishments.



"Second, even if the codes apply to an establishment, governments have enormous flexibility to waive requirements for workplace safety, social security and protection from lay-offs, retrenchment or closure. "Third, the codes significantly weaken the ability of workers to fight for their rights, by making it more difficult to form a union,

declaring any strike without two weeks' notice illegal, and penalising those who support such a strike.

"Finally, and most importantly, the codes ignore key challenges facing workers. How can crores of workers with no written contract be helped? How can contract workers' position be improved? A worker struggles when they lose their job or

suffer an injury -- how can this struggle be reduced? The codes are silent, "Kharge said.

The Congress president said that "clearly, the Modi government thinks of labour laws as an inconvenience to be removed. It does not understand that labour laws, when well-designed and enforced. both protect workers and create certainty for businesses".

He further said that "this is why BJP governments in states like Uttar Pradesh and Madhya Pradesh have been unable to attract foreign investors in manufacturing despite waiving key labour laws for three years, citing Covid-19 as an excuse".

The death toll in the Bhiwandi building crash in Maharashtra's Thane district rose to eight with two more bodies recovered from the debris, officials said here on Monday. # India's slipping press freedom ranking raises concerns

he latest World Press Freedom Index by global media watchdog Reporters Without Borders (RSF) paints a concerning picture for India's media landscape. The country's ranking has slipped to 161 out of 180 countries, a worrying decline from the previous year's position of 150. This downward trend raises significant concerns about the state of press freedom in the world's largest democracy. In contrast, neighbouring Pakistan has shown some improvement, securing the 150th rank, a slight advancement from its previous position of 157. Sri Lanka has also made strides, moving up to the 135th position from its previous rank of 146. These developments highlight the importance of safeguarding media freedom and the critical role it plays in democratic societies. Norway, Ireland, and Denmark occupy the top three positions in press freedom, reflecting their commitment to upholding the principles of free expression and an independent media. On the other end of the spectrum, Vietnam, China, and North Korea find themselves in the bottom three, underscoring the significant challenges faced by journalists in these countries. India's slipping press freedom ranking is a cause for concern. A vibrant and independent media is vital for a robust democracy. It plays a critical role in holding those in power accountable, providing citizens with reliable information, and fostering public debate. A decline in press freedom undermines these fundamental pillars of democracy and poses a threat to transparency, good governance, and the public's right to know. It is essential for the Indian government to recognize the significance of a free and independent media and take necessary steps to protect and promote press freedom. This includes ensuring the safety and security of journalists, creating an environment that fosters investigative journalism, and addressing any undue political, economic, or social pressures that hinder media freedom. re we closer to the Sustainable Development Goal (SDG-8) of providing decent and productive mployment to all job seekers in the country by 2030? The recent trend of economic growth and unemployment statistics show that we are probably not. To achieve this, there is a need of a quantum jump in the overall economic growth and growth in job generating sectors, in the next few years

Indian economy has not recovered from the covid-19 pandemic crisis yet. The post pandemic period witnessed a relatively higher growth of 9 percent in 2021-22 (at 2011-12 constant prices) owing to a lower GDP base in 2020-21. But the growth failed to keep this momentum as Russia-Ukraine military conflict started in early 2022 disrupted the global supply chain. The oil economy has been badly affected, which spills over to the sectors of the economy

Indian economy is not free from the global slowdown. Its growth has come down to 6.7 percent in 2022-23. The current year i.e., 2023-24 is expected to witness a further slowdown of the economy. As projected by the Reserve Bank of India and the Economic Survey,2022-23, the economic growth is likely to be around 6 percent in 2023-24. Economic growth is essential for job creation. Employment further generates consumption and investment demand which further accelerates growth, and the cycle continues. The impact of gradual slowdown in the economy in the previous two years and the expected slowdown in the current year has been felt in the job market.

According to the latest round of Periodic Labour Force Survey (PLFS), 2023, the third quarter i.e., October to December of 2022, unemployment rate was 7.2 percent. The unemployment rate continues to rise in 2023. The updated figure received from CMIE shows that the unemployment rate stands at 8.1 percent as on April, this year. According to the CMIE sources, the



unemployment curve has been witnessing an upward trend since January.

A group of economists and public policy enthusiasts opine that the recent rise in the rate of unemployment is due to a rise in Labour Force Participation Rate (LFPR). During 2021 and 2022, India's LFPR in the age group of 15 and above in the urban areas has increased from 47.3 percent to 48.2 percent, as reported by the PLFS quarterly report released in February 2023. The urban female LFPR has increased from 20 percent to 22.3 percent whereas, the urban male LFPR has declined from 73.9 percent to 73.3 percent during the same period.

Globally, India stands as one among the countries having a lower LFPR. The International Labour Organisation (ILO) estimate shows that India's LFPR is 49 percent compared to the world average LFPR of 59 percent as in 2021. The LFPR in Europe and United States is 61 percent and 57 percent respectively. Even in the neighbouring countries such as, Pakistan and Bangladesh, the LFPR stands at 53 percent and 58 percent respectively in the same year.

At the state level in India, the LFPR in the age group of 15 and above follows a skewed distribution with no sign of any match with state's economic status. In the states such as Andhra Pradesh, Chhattisgarh and Himachal Pradesh, the LFPR in the urban area is above 60 percent. In the relatively developed states such as Delhi and Goa, the LFPR in the urban area is 47 percent and 43 percent respectively. Bihar as a lower percapita income state falls in this group with a lower LFPR of 41 percent. Surprisingly, the urban female LFPR in Delhi is 12 percent as in 2021.

The rise in LFPR is a symbol of economic progress as it presents rising interest among the youth to participate in economic activity. This interest helps to bring quality and diversity to the labour force and thus enhances its strength. It also helps to reduce the productivity gap in the economy.

The recent rise in India's LFPR and particularly, the female LFPR in recent times as reported by the PLFS and CMIE is a challenge for the country. The demographic structure of India shows that even a smaller rise in LFPR would release a large labour force and would shift the supply curve to the right. At this stage if the economy is not in shape of expansion, the additional labour force would badly impact the wage rate and disrupt the atmosphere

Therefore, the recent slowdown in economic growth as mentioned above is a concern for job market. However, the recovery in the sectors such as tourism and manufacturing and their growth momentum during the post pandemic period is a sign of hope of creating employment opportunities in a decent way.

The tourism sector has witnessed relatively higher growth as per the expectations. The trade, hotels and restaurants which contribute to the growth in tourism sector was down by over 23 percent in 2020-21 and but, has recovered with a relatively higher growth rate of 13 percent in 2021-22. The growth rate in the sector in the last three quarters in 2022-23 is estimated to be 25 percent, 15 percent and 9 percent respectively.

The manufacturing sector witnessed growth rate of 2.9 percent in 2020-21 when the overall economic growth was down by 5.8 percent. In 2021-22, the rowth in the manufacturing sector rose to 11 percent. However, after registering a growth rate of 6 percent in the first quarter of 2022-23, the manufacturing sector slid by over 3 percent in its second and the third quarter.

Economic growth and its diversity are essential to provide decent jobs to the people of the country. No doubt, the economy has shown adequate resilience to maintain its growth momentum amid various global headwinds. India stands as one of the fastest growing economies during the post-covid 19 pandemics according to the report by IMF World Economic Outlook, released in April,2023. The external world is optimistic about India. The larger domestic consumer base has supported the economy to defend against any global recession. With this optimism if the economy grows with double digit growth, we can create opportunity for every job seeker of the country and reach the SDG-8 target before the scheduled time.

partition Bengal, delving into the cultural nuances and the friendly rivalries between the Bangaals and the Ghotis.



**MUMBAI**: The Nifty, after a weak run in the last four months, bounced back in April with 4.1 per cent MoM gain, Motilal Oswal Financial Services said in a report.

Notably, the index was extremely volatile and swung around 776 points before closing 705 points higher. Nifty50 has been underperforming the emerging markets and the world indices in CY23YTD amid varied global macro headwinds viz., inflation, interest rates, and currency, the report said.

While most of the global equity markets are rising 5-20 per cent in CY23YTD, India is flat in local currency, the report said. The Nifty Midcap 100 (+5.9 per cent MoM) and Nifty Smallcap 100 (+7.5 per cent) outperformed the Nifty50 during the month.

FIIs recorded inflows for the second consecutive month.

FIIs remained net buyers for the second straight month at \$1.9 billion in Apr'23, after recording inflows of \$1.8 billion in Mar'23; YTD outflows stood at \$0.6 billion. DII inflows ebbed in Apr'23 at \$0.3 billion. and stood at \$10.4 billion YTD. All major sectors end higher







Tesla CEO Elon Musk has agreed to pay \$10,000 to settle a defamation case brought against him by Indian-American Sikh critic and independent researcher, Randeep Singh Hothi.

Hothi, a doctoral student in Asian Languages and Cultures at the University of Michigan. had filed a defamation case against Musk in 2020, alleging that the billionaire businessman falsely accused him of actively harassing and "almost killing" Tesla employees.

Following a lengthy and hard-fought litigation, in March 2023, Musk asked Hothi to settle the case. "This case was about taking a stand, not seeking fame or money. I feel vindicated, " said Hothi, announcing that he accepted Musk's settlement offer in a statement. "I brought this case to defend my work, clear my name, and send a message ... I believe I've accomplished that, thanks in no small part to Musk, whose own behaviour over the

When Hothi and his legal team successfully obtained a court order requiring Tesla to hand over video evidence of the alleged encounter, Tesla abruptly dropped its lawsuit in July 2019. Yet the following month, Musk e-mailed a reporter accusing Hothi of "actively harassing" and "almost kill(ing)" Tesla employees. That remark was later published and amplified to hundreds of thousands of people on Twitter.

Musk's accusations prompted an outpouring of public support for Hothi, including from whistleblowers, researchers, journalists, and critics. In August 2020, represented by Sperlein, Hothi filed a defamation lawsuit against Musk based on his remarks. Musk attempted to dispose of the case by arguing that his accusations were protected speech, and hence should be dismissed under California's anti-SLAPP law.

Canada has summoned Chinese Ambassador Cong Peiwu over allegations of political interference and intimidation, the media reported.

Foreign Affairs Minister Melanie Joly disclosed the news on Thursday during a heated exchange in Ottawa with opposition lawmaker Michael Chong, now at the centre of the accusations against

China, reports CNN. Chong was allegedly tar geted for harassment by Beijing, and has fiercely criticized the slow response of Prime Minister Justin Trudeau's government Joly also told MPs during

a foreign affairs committee session that Canada is considering taking retaliatory action against China and that "all options are on the table", including diplomatic expulsions.

However, she admitted Canada's government was carefully weighing the possibility of retaliation by China, which denies interfering in Canadian political affairs.

### **NHS worker jailed** for sending threat letter to ex-Home **Secy Priti Patel**



LONDON: A National Health Service (NHS) worker has been jailed for five months for abusing and threatening to "tear" former Indian-origin Home Secretary Priti Patel "to pieces' in a letter, a media report said.

Pooneeraj Canakiah, 65, from Hackney, sent the letter in January 2022 when Patel was still in charge at the Home Office in the Boris Johnson's government, the Evening Stanard newspaper reported.

Canakiah marked the letter 'personal", hoping that Patel would open it herself but it was intercepted by security staff before it reached her.

"Your time is coming to an end -- be prepared we will get you, " Canakiah wrote in the letter, abusing Patel, "Be pre-pared, b\*\*\*\*".

"If we don't get you, we will wait and wait and wait, " he wrote, threatening to "tear you to pieces".

Prosecutor David Burns said the letter went on to make a series of lewd suggestions about sex between Patel and Johnson, the report said.

Canakiah was identified by his handwriting, and he pleaded guilty to sending the letter during his first court hearing in March, the Westminster magistrates court heard.

Sentencing Canakiah to five months in prison, District Judge Briony Clarke said the letter shocked her every time she read it.

"It's an attack on democracy", The Standard quoted her as saying.

"You sent a letter which was disgusting and threatening in nature, it was addressed to a serving MP who at the time was Home Secretary. It was vile in nature, including threats, it was offensive and vulgar, " Clarke said.

### US will end Covid vax requirements for federal employees, int'l travellers



The US administration announced it will end Covid-19 vaccination requirements for federal employees, international air travellers and contractors on May 11 -- the same day that the public health emergency implemented for the pandemic will also end.

In a statement on Monday, the White House said the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) and Department of Homeland Security (DHS) also separately announced that they will start the process to end their vaccination requirements for head start educators, CMS-certified healthcare facilities, and certain non-citizens at the land

border. "The federal government successfully implemented equirements f force in a way that increased vaccination to achieve 98 per cent compliance, reflecting employees who had received at least one dose of a vaccine or had a pending or approved exception or extension request filed by January 2022. "We also put in place vaccination requirements for certain international travellers to slow the spread of new variants entering the country and to allow our healthcare system time to effectively manage access to care if faced with an increase in cases and hospitalisations, " said the statement.

#### Canadian poet Rupi Kaur's 'Milk and Honey' was banned in the US classrooms A Canadian- poet, Rupi Kaur whose Twitter account was withheld in India last month over the Khalistan issue, now has her debut work among the 11 most banned books in the US classrooms for the first half of the 2022-23 school year.

Rupi Kaur's 'Milk and Honey', which released in 2014, was banned for exploring

issues of sexual assault and violence, according to data provided by non-profit PEN America. The book, banned in multiple districts in Missouri this year, tied in ninth place with Toni Morrison's 'The Bluest Eye', according to the report. Both books were reportedly banned in 10 districts in the first half of this school year alone.

"It deeply concerns me that there is a group of people hell bent on taking away literature that students find refuge in, " Punjab-born Kaur wrote in an Instagram post last week.



Apart from violene, the rest of the titles in the list discussed race and racism, LGBTQ+ characters, grief or death, student health and wellbeing, and teen pregnancy, abortion or sexual assault. "Parents want to ban books to protect their kids but teachers and librarians say that students are old enough to be aware of the topics discussed in these books. Many actually

seek these books out because they're going through those experiences themselves, "she wrote.

Kaur's work encompasses

love, loss, trauma, healing, femininity, and migration. "I remember sitting in my school library in high school, turning to books about sexual assault because I didn't have anyone else to turn to. This is the reality for many students, she said in her post. "We all find comfort in literature that reflects our experiences. now that books about sexual assault and other topics are being banned -- I worry for students who rely on school libraries for

access to literature. This isn't the first time Kaur responded to her book being banned. She commented on Instagram about a ban that went into effect in two states last year, according to NBC News. "Over the last few months parts of Texas and Oregon have banned or attempted to ban 'Milk and Honey' from schools and libraries. Why? Because it explores sexual assault and violence ex-

perienced by a young woman, " she wrote. The award-winning poet immigrated to Canada at age four with her Sikh parents and grew up in a suburb of Toronto. The Sun and her Flowers (2017) and Home Body (2020) are among the other titles that

with Milk and Honey surpassing Homer's Odyssey as the best-selling poetry of all time, according to Kaur's website. She was also regarded as writer of the decade" by the New Republic and recognised on the Forbes 30 under 30 list.

In 2022, Kaur released her fourth book, 'Healing Through Word'. However, there have been plagiarism allegations on Kaur, saving she stole her poetry style and content from Nayyirah Waheed and Pavana Reddy.

### S.Korean President's approval rating rebounds after 4 weeks: Poll

South Korean President Yoon Suk Yeol's approval rating has rebounded for the first time in four weeks, thanks to positive feedback on his recent state visit to the US, a poll revealed on Monday.



In the poll of 2, 507 adults aged 18 or older conducted by Realmeter from April 24-28, the positive assessment of the President's performance went up 1.8 percentage points from the previous week to 34.5 per cent, reports Yonhap News Agency.

The result marked Yoon's highest performance in public

polls since the 36.7 per cent figure in the last week of March. His disapproval rating was 62.6 per cent, down 2.1 percentage points from the previous week.

According to Bae Cheol-ho, a senior analyst at Realmeter, last week's approval rating can be attributed entirely to Yoon's six-day state visit to the US designed to mark the 70th anniversary of the bilateral alliance this year.




