## RBI to withdraw Rs 2,000 currency notes from Manish Sisodia stresses on 'Transformative circulation, can be exchanged till Sept 30

New Delhi

The Reserve Bank of India on Friday announced withdrawal of Rs 2,000 currency notes from circulation, and existing notes in circulation can either be deposited in bank accounts or exchanged by September 30.

The bank notes in Rs 2,000 denomination will continue to be a legal tender, the RBI said in a statement.

In order to ensure operational convenience and to avoid disruption of regular activities of bank branches. the RBI said exchange of Rs 2,000 bank notes into bank notes of other denominations can be made up to a limit of Rs 20,000 at a time at any bank starting from May 23, 2023.

**NEW DELHI:** The government on

Friday said no TCS will be levied on international spending of up to Rs 7 lakh a year by using debit or credit cards. Facing backlash from a wide section of people, the Finance Ministry said the move is aimed at removing procedural ambiguity with regard to Liberalised Remittance Scheme (LRS) and the levying of Tax Collected at Source (TCS). The ministry's decision earlier this week to bring international credit card spending under the RBI's liberalised remittance scheme (LRS) and the consequent levy of 20 per cent TCS has evoked sharp reactions from experts and stakeholders. "To avoid any procedural ambiguity, it has been decided that any payments by an individual using their international Debit or Credit cards up to Rs 7 lakh per financial year will be excluded from the LRS limits and hence, will not attract any TCS," the ministry said in a statement.

## SEBI probe into Adani drew a blank: Supreme Court-appointed panel

The Supreme Courtappointed panel said "it would not be possible for the committee to conclude that there has been a regulatory failure around the allegation of price manipulation"

**NEW DELHI:** A six-member expert committee constituted by the Supreme Court in the Hindenburg-Adani allegations case and headed by former Supreme Court judge, Justice A.M. Sapre — said that the Securities Exchange Board of India (SEBI) has "drawn a blank" and is in a "chicken-and-egg situation" in its investigation into the "ownership" of 13 overseas entities, including 12 Foreign Portfolio

Investors (FPIs). The 173-page report said,

"SEBI has found 42 contributories to the assets under management of the 13 overseas entities. Various avenues have been pursued - including ED, CBDT and various market regulators in the seven jurisdictions where the contributories are situated. SEBI has drawn a blank".

The foundation of SEBI's suspicion that led to investigations into the overseas entities' ownership is that they have "opaque structures", because the chain of ownership of the 13 entities was not clear.

The committee said that SEBI was investigating the ownership of the 13 entities since October 2020, with regard to allegations in the Hindenburg report about minimum public shareholding.

"The key issue is whether as the law stands, one could draw a conclusion that the FPIs are fronts for the promoters of the



Adani Group... If such an outcome in the investigation would come about, it would mean that the promoters would not be compliant with the minimum public shareholding requirement," the report pointed out.

While it emphasised the need for a "coherent enforcement policy", the committee concluded that it would not be possible to return a finding of "regulatory failure" in compli-

ance with stipulations governing minimum public shareholding. The Justice Sapre committee

said that the conundrum faced by the market regulator was due to a change in the legislative policy of SEBI under the FPI Regulations 2014 on the basis of a recommendation by a Working Group in 2018. As the law stands, FPIs need to only declare their "beneficial owner", and not the "last natu-

ral person above every person owning economic interest in the FPI", in conformation with the anti-money laundering law.

"In 2018, the very provision dealing with 'opaque structure' and requiring an FPI to be able to disclose every ultimate natural person at the end of the chain of every owner of economic interest in the FPI was done away with," the report observed.

It said that for the SEBI to put to rest its suspicions, its investigation would require information about the "ultimate economic ownership" — and not just the "beneficial owners" — of the 13 overseas entities under its lens.

The committee said that it was this "dichotomy" between the law as it stood post-2018 on the one hand, and what SEBI wants on the other, that has led the market regulator to draw a blank despite its best efforts.

As per the coach combination, moving in the direction from Delhi to Meerut, the second coach of the trainset, i.e. just after the premium coach will be the women's coach. Whereas while moving to Delhi from Meerut it will be the second last coach of the train i.e. just before the premium coach.

Talking about this facility, an official informed that "Proper signage is being provided for identification of these women coaches at the platform level and on the train door openings. This reserved coach will have 72 seating capacity. Additional 10 seats are also reserved for women in other coaches of the train".

## Sisodia confesses to destroying Delhi's former Deputy Chief Min-

ister Manish Sisodia has reportedly confessed to destroying two mobile phones which were sought by the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) in connection with the Delhi excise policy scam case. On July 22, 2022, the Union

Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) directed the CBI to initiate a case in the excise scam. Sources claim that from that day onwards, Sisodia started using a new mobile phone. While probing the matter, the CBI learnt that Sisodia had been using three different mobile phones between January 1, 2020 and August 19, 2022.

On August 19, 2022, the probe agency conducted search peration and sezied one phone from Sisodia's possession.

We later discovered that the mobile phone seized from Sisodia's possession had been used by him from July 22, 2022. This was the date when we were

instructed by the MHA to initiate the case in the excise matter, " a source said. During the interrogation, Sisodia reportedly confessed to the probe agency that he had destroyed two mobile phones. "Prior to this, I was



## Will Rs 2,000 note withdrawal be good for digital economy?

he Reserve Bank of India's recent decision to withdraw the Rs 2,000 denomination notes from circulation, in compliance with its "Clean Note Policy", bears a disconcerting echo of the tumultuous demonetisation phase. The notes, introduced in November 2016 as a swift remedy to replenish currency following the withdrawal of the Rs 500 and Rs 1,000 notes, will remain legal tender, much like the similar step taken in 2013-2014. The central bank's move, while rooted in a legitimate purpose, is likely to place strain on an already stressed banking system. The public, accustomed to seamless banking operations, is poised to face some disruption. This may evoke unwelcome memories of the enormous crowds that once surged into bank branches, seeking to exchange old notes for new. Members of the public have been urged to deposit their Rs 2,000 notes into their bank accounts or exchange them for other denominations. The Reserve Bank has established a cap of Rs 20,000 for the exchange of the high denomination notes in a bid to streamline operations and avoid major disruptions in regular bank activities. This service will be available at all banks and 19 regional offices of the RBI starting May 23, 2023. The Bank's commitment to providing adequate time for this transition is laudable. Directing banks to offer deposit and exchange services for the Rs 2,000 notes until September 30, 2023, safeguards the interests of the public, ensuring a smoother transition period. However, the impact of this decision on the economy should not be overlooked. The RBI cites the reason behind the move as a decline in the circulation and transactional use of the Rs 2,000 notes, which, once essential to an immediate crisis, have seen their role in the economy diminish with time. Will the latest move streamline the nation's currency system and further its journey towards a digital economy is yet to be seen.

## Rising prices and falling dreams

iquor sales in India, according to recent report, have surged despite steep price hikes. Realtors have been able to pass on higher prices as housing demand in the country remains robust. Higher prices or inflation appear acceptable as long as demand absorbs them. However, for the majority of the middle and lower-middle-class population, home ownership has become an even more distant dream. The bustling scenes at restaurants and pubs in urban areas seem less affected by any price hikes. Still, the same inflation deprives a laborer's family of their livelihood as the sole breadwinner spends his entire earnings on alcohol. Inflation most severely impacts those at the bottom of the economic pyramid, driving them deeper into poverty.

According to the latest inflation data, India's Wholesale Price Index (WPI) has been decelerating faster than the Consumer Price Index (CPI) over the last few months. This disparity suggests that corporate India has benefited from lower input costs while continuing to charge consumers higher prices. This situation is apparent in recent corporate results, where companies reported improved sales mostly due to price hikes (despite muted volume growth) and enhanced margins. Improved revenues led to better salary hikes, and lower costs boosted companies bottom lines, translating to better dividend payouts. However, consumers have not benefitted from price cuts.

Government employees are somewhat insulated from price hikes as their dearness allowances have compensated them to some extent. But in India, where only 1 percent of the population is salaried and 98 percent earn less than 5 lakhs per annum, inflation only delays the upliftment of these people and hampers our progress toward becoming a wealthier nation. The problem was exacerbated by Covid, which



further widened the wealth gap

Price controls seem the most logical way for the government to control inflation. Still, they have proven ineffective in the long run, often leading to less innovation and growth. Restrictive policies are quickly opposed by corporates and industries, as they find less incentive to innovate, expand, or invest. Monetary mechanisms like raising interest rates and tightening liquidity seem the most probable ways to tackle inflation.

Inflation caused by supply disruptions, such as the ongoing Russia-Ukraine war, are hard to handle, but demand-driven inflation can be curbed by making the availability of funds, which are driving the demand, costlier. Central bankers around the world find raising rates most effective in curbing rising prices. Interest rates are a key factor in determining the valuation of financial instruments and their market prices. Any steep change in the rates over a short period will lead to price mismatches, as witnessed during the 2008 Lehman Brothers debacle.

In the last year, a steep Federal Reserve rate hike of 500 basis points has brought down inflation by 400 basis points in the same period. This change has already created ripples among small and mediumsized US banks and instilled contagion fears in the financial markets.

While the free-market theory is challenging to apply in economic and public policy, it is more or less in vogue in the financial markets, where unrestricted demand and supply of securities determine their prices. The Central Bankers' role today has become trickier as they balance the economic impacts of rate increases and tackle the impacts caused by financial excesses in the markets. Every time the Fed Chairman speaks and tries to curb market optimism, the market interprets it as a sign that rates have peaked and a reason to rally further. A decade-long low-interest-rate regime between 2010 and 2020 led to a 300 percent rally in the S&P 500, only to revert to the mean due to the Covid pandemic. Increased interest rates have put a cap on the market rally for

now, but as inflation and rates appear to have peaked, equity markets are finding fresh reasons to rally to previous highs. However, as the lagged impacts of interest rate hikes have just started to materialise, prudent investors are apprehensive about the next possible downturn.

While easy access to cheap funds has created excesses in financial markets, leading to unrealistic prices, these tend to correct themselves when market disruptions occur. Excessive speculation, fueled by financing tools like margin funding, exacerbates the impact of these disruptions, often resulting in significant losses for less informed investors.

Central banks now have a more complex role than ever. They need to manage the economic impacts of rate increases while also addressing the impacts caused by these financial market excesses. It's ironic that every time the Federal Reserve Chairman attempts to curb optimism in the markets, the markets interpret it as an indication that rates have peaked, seeing this as a reason to rally even further.

The long period of low interest rates from 2010 to 2020 resulted in a 300 percent rally in the S&P 500, which was eventually reined in by the Covid crisis. Though increased interest rates have stemmed the tide of the market rally for now, as inflation and rates seem to have peaked, equity markets are finding new

notivations to rally back to previous highs. However, the delayed impacts of interest rate hikes are just beginning to surface, and savvy investors are anxious about the potential for the next market downturn. It's a challenging period in the financial world, and the path forward will require careful navigation to balance the varied and often competing interests at play.

## Rajasthan's move spells some hope for gig workers



e Chief Minister of Rajasthan announced earlier this year that the State would set up India's first welfare fund called the Rajasthan Platform-Based Gig Workers Social Security and Welfare Fund. This is the first real instance of a regulatory move to unburden gig and platform workers' vulnerabilities since the Code on Social Security was passed in 2020. The code came amid the COVID-19 pandemic when platform workers became the backbone of metropolitan logistics, acting to serve customers, and working with and for State governments in their food relief

In 2023, many State governments are yet to pass rules that govern how they will implement the Code on Social Security. This has raised concerns over how fast gig and platform workare seen as "independent contractors", though they are made to follow rules that constitute an employment relationship. Rajasthan stands out as a first mover making haste, with the State facing Assembly elections next year.

 $Since\ Independence, construction\ workers,$ dock workers, and head loaders (mathadi) have had boards set up for their well-being. Thus, the Rajasthan Platform-based Gig Workers Welfare Board will be a familiar institution that can be used to serve the needs of a technologymediated workforce. The board, a tripartite institution with representatives from bureaucracy. employers or clients, and workers' unions or associations, exists as a workaround to what is otherwise embedded in formal employment. In the latter, an employment contract and contributory worker benefits bring together worker, state and employer in conversation with each other. This relationship is meant to ensure quick communication in moments of failure where workers or employers do not get



between the parties. In sectors that have more way to deliver benefits since on-paper employment relationships are missing. Therefore, the state also does not 'find' workers at work to give them benefits. The tripartite relationship has to be built to force employers to acknowledge that they have informal workers; for workers to collectivise to bring a common voice to their concerns; and for the state to liaise and mediate this relationship.

#### Tied down in the specifics

The Rajasthan Platform-based Gig Workers Welfare Board aims to deliver social security benefits to between three to four lakh workers in the State but is tied down in what kind of schemes and programmes it can set up. The Code on Social Security gives State labour ministries the mandate of choosing from a narrow bouquet of programmes on provident fund, employment injury benefit, housing, educational schemes for children of workers, skill upgrading and funeral assistance. Key cover, health and maternity benefits, old age and funded by the central government, which can decide which States will get these central schemes, their duration and what kind of gig and platform worker will be eligible for schemes and programmes. This restriction could be further exacerbated by a lack or shortage of funding

To address this, the code mandates platforms to share 1%-2% of their revenue for these new schemes, answering a key question for central and State governments as to who pays for gig and platform worker protections. The Construction Worker Board uses a similar avenue to take money that amounts to 1%-2% of the project cost from real estate companies and builders for worker well-being. While charging construction projects on revenue is a simple way to fund a board, it will not be as simple to do so in the platform economy context. Many platform companies operate as revenue-negative or have to raise debt or equity funding to make it year to year. Questions about how the Rajasthan

government made the financial allocation of Rs 200 crore, where this has come from, or how platforms will be charged with their financial esponsibility remain unanswered.

#### The challenge ahead

Worker boards in India have been thought of as a way to build long-term relationships between workers and the state apart from their more operational role in creating a tripartite forum and implementing schemes. There has been a lot of criticism against the construction board — that it does not provide benefits that are useful enough to offset the time, money and other resources workers have to spend in order to register and access benefits. Time will tell how a Gig and Platform Worker Board will fare when gig and platform workers are time-poor at they often work wages that are structured through hourly or daily time commitments to platforms. This has been a significant challenge for collectivisation attempts. It is also unclear whether Rajasthan or any other State board will be able to fill the gap in labour rights for platform and gig workers. The Code on Social Security does not consider how to handle the labour rights of gig and platform workers; rather, it only seeks to give them protections from vulnerable aspects of their work.

Nonetheless, the initiation of the board is a big win for platform workers and unions who/ which have been fighting to get their issues heard. The fact that the board is being set up before 2024 stands out in the midst of political chatter that States will not implement the new Codes until after the general election in 2024.

## Book offers a Deep Dive into India's nationalist discourse

n 'The Nation and its Citizens,' Sukumar Muralidharan takes a deep dive into the often unsettling realities of nationalism and capitalism, and their intertwined relationship. This masterful piece of work provides readers with a broader historical and geographical context, linking the current state of affairs in India with worldwide economic and political trends. against misconceptions that a liberal market economy could serve as a cure-all for social unrest and xenophobia.





### Crypto exchange Binance exits Canada market due to new policies

Leading blockchain and cryptocurrency platform Binance has announced its exit from the Canadian marketplace due to new stablecoin and investor limits in the country.

"We are announcing that prominent crypto businesses in proactively withdrawing from the Canadian marketplace, " the company said in a tweet.

"We had high hopes for the rest of the Canadian blockchain industry. Unfortunately, new guidance related to stablecoins and investor limits provided to crypto exchanges makes the Canada market no



longer tenable for Binance at this time, "it added.

The cryptocurrency platform also stated that while it does not agree with the new regulations. it hopes to continue working with Canadian regulators to develop a regulatory framework for cryptocurrencies.

According to CoinDesk, the Canadian Securities Administrators (CSA) issued new guidance in February prohibiting crypto asset trading platforms in the country from allowing answer website for programcustomers to buy or deposit mers, has laid off 10 per cent of proval from the CSA.

To obtain approval, the crypto trading platform would have to pass the CSA's various due diligence checks.

In March, the US Commodity Futures and Trading Commission (CFTC) sued Binance for allegedly breaking trading and derivatives rules, media





#### RBI approves Rs 87,416 crore dividend payout to GoI for 2022-23



MUMBAI: The Reserve Bank on Friday approved Rs 87,416 crore dividend payout to the central government for 2022-23, nearly triple of what it paid in the previous year. The dividend payout was Rs 30,307 crore for accounting year 2021-22. The decision was taken at the 602nd meeting of the Central Board of Directors of Reserve Bank of India held under the chairmanship of Governor Shaktikanta Das. "The board approved the transfer of Rs 87,416 crore as surplus to the central government for accounting year 2022-23, while deciding to keep the Contingency Risk Buffer at 6 per cent," RBI said in a statement. The board also reviewed the global and domestic economic situation and associated challenges, including the impact of current global geopolitical developments. The board also discussed the working of RBI during 2022-23 and approved the annual report and accounts of the central bank for the year.

## Crypto exchanges Upbit, Bithumb raided in crypto scandal



Prosecutors raided two of South Korea's local cryptocurrency exchanges on Monday as part of an investigation into the snowballing suspicions surrounding opposition lawmaker Kim Nam-kuk's digital assets, officials said.

A team of investigators from the Seoul Southern District Prosecutors Office seized transaction records and other materials from Upbit and Bithumb, they said, reports Yonhap news agency.

## Hunter Biden works in favor of Islamist party in Bangladesh

A review of emails and documents on Hunter Biden's infamous laptop reveal a March 2016 meeting with then-US ambassador to Romania Hans Klemm on the topic of a corruption case against Gabriel Popoviciu. According to information, Popoviciu made more than US\$1 million in wire payments to Hunter Biden from November 2015 to June 2017 as he battled corruption charges in his home country. Being a paid lobbyist of Gabriel Popoviciu, Hunter Biden met twice with Ambassador Hans Klemm, first in November 2015 and again in March 2016.

Emails show, at that time, Hunter Biden was a consultant for a law firm named Boies Schiller Flexner and worked with lawyers from the firm to lobby the US embassy in Bucharest to intervene in Gabriel Popoviciu's case. Law firm Boies Schiller partner Christopher Boies told Biden in a September 1, 2015 email that his law partner - whom he never identified—was "best friends" with the newly appointed ambassador to Romania, Hans Klemm.

According to US Congress Oversight report, Gabriel Popoviciu's first wire payment amounting to US\$59,900 was sent to Hunter Biden on November 9, 2015. Four days after that, Hunter Biden and Boies Schiller partner Michael Gottlieb discussed a meet- company Hunter Biden also ing with Ambassador Hans Klemm and provided him reports about the Popoviciu case, which they said showed the corruption charges were bogus. The emails indicate that Biden attended the meeting, and Biden's calendar shows a meeting with Klemm at Lapis restaurant in Washington, DC, on March 30, 2016.

Emails show that Hans Klemm was receptive to the reports and arranged meetings for the Biden consortium with Romanian officials. On May 17, 2016, Gottlieb contacted Klemm to seek help in meeting scandalous with Romania's anti-corruption service, the DNA. In 2018, OPJ, hired Husch Blackwell Strategies, LLC to ensure that "the United States Government policies, while currently supportive of political stability and democracy, development, and human rights in Bangladesh, do not shift in any manner contrary to the interests of Jamaat-e-Islami, nor create an environment where JI is defined as a security threat within Bangladesh or on an international scale". The submitted documents suggest that OPJ was acting for the Jamaat as the lobbyist as the form confirmed OPJ as being a "foreign politi-

cal party". In 2014, OPJ hired Cassidy and Associates which "engaged in educational meetings about human rights violations and provided strategic advice in an effort to prevent members of Jamaat-e-Islami Party from being prosecuted and executed by a politically motivated and government influenced tribunal". 


But, the actor, who plays Wasim Khan, staved true to his character and braved every bullet, just to deliver his role to perfection.

### Five accounts responsible for leaking clips of upcoming SRK-starrer 'Jawan' The Delhi High Court on names, phone numbers in respect

Wednesday directed social media platform Twitter to provide Basic Subscriber Information (BSI) and other relevant details of five accounts responsible for leaking clips related to the upcoming Shah Rukh Khanstarrer "Jawan". After the clips got leaked,

the high court, on April 25, had directed social media platforms, 'shady' websites, cable TV outlets, direct-to-home services, and various other platforms to remove the leaked clips and stop their circulation as well. Red Chillies Entertainment Private Ltd, a production house owned by Khan and his wife Gauri, had filed a lawsuit in the high court on this count. The entertainment company's counsel submitted before the bench of Justice C. Hari Shankar that the a fresh application was filed in view of certain additional



leaks committed by the Twitter accounts in question.

It is the company's case that the nature of the leaks suggest that those running the Twitter handles had "accessed systems" of the plaintiff company.

Therefore, the application seeks a direction on Twitter to disclose the BSI and other details including IP addresses, userof the five Twitter handles. Disposing of the application, Justice Shankar ordered: "Thus court directs the defendant no. 2 (Twitter) to provide information of five accounts by way of an affidavit as an additional document with advanced copy to the counsel of the plaintiff so that the plaintiff can take appropriate action." He had earlier directed social

media sites like YouTube, Google, Twitter, and Reddit to take action to halt the circulation of the movie's copyrighted content and ordered a number of internet service providers to prohibit access to websites that were showing or making the movie's footage available for viewing or downloading. Two movierelated video snippets, according to the petitioner, were leaked on social media, one showing Shah Rukh Khan in a fight sequence, and the second showing a dance
