About 16 months ago Punjab government launched operation against drug smuggling in the state as a result 21786 drug smugglers were arrested by state police and pushed ithe bars so far. Bhagwant government not only launched campaign in Punjab state but also in Gujarat and Maharashtra states from where drug supplies were being made and delivered at seaport with the help of Special Task Force and Anti-gangster Task Force, which succeeded in arresting several hard core criminals along with nearly 1068 declared offenders by the courts and were absconding since past couple of years, presently lodged in jails in past over a year.



'Nasha Mukti Abhiyan' Punjab police has recovered 1044.31 kg Opium, 525.69 kg Bhukki, 2.21 kg Smack, 15.25 kg Ganja, 47.21 kg Charas, 1239.49 kg Heroine and 86,28,522 intoxicated tablets, capsules and injections. 2,444 Women-led MSMEs reported Shut Down in FY23



NEW DELHI : About 2,444 number of women-headed MSMEs closed during the period of 2022-23, as per Udyam Portal, informed Minister of State for Micro. Small and Medium Enterprises, Bhanu Pratap Singh Verma in a written reply to the Lok Sabha on Thursday.

In the current fiscal year till 4 May 2023 total 320 MSMEs led by women have shut down so far and during FY 2021-22 the tally was 1,040, as per the official government data.

The MoS also shared the umber of women own MSMEs registered on Udyam Portal of Ministry of MSME. According to year-wise data, 652,715 women owned MSMEs have been registered so far in the present financial vear till 8 August 2023.

After the Rajya Sabha ratified the Delhi Services Bill, Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal on Monday said it was a 'black day' for India's democracy and accused that the BJP-led Central government is stealthily seizing authority.

This divisive bill, which passed with a count of 131 to 102 in the Rajya Sabha, empowers the Central government to supervise the bureaucracy within the Delhi government. Home Minister Amit Shah defended the Government of National Capital Territory of Delhi (Amendment) Bill, 2023, saving the proposed legislation is aimed at providing effective and corruption-free governance in the national capital. The recent legislation dictates that the

Centre will oversee the transfer and duties of Delhi government employees across all ries Keiriwal in his critique, humorously questioned if such policies would lead the prime minister to micromanage even the daily tasks of a low-level government peon. Will the prime minister now sit and decide what work a peon of the Delhi government will do? Is this the job of the prime minister?,' asked Kejriwal. Expressing his gratitude, the Aam Aadmi Party chief lauded several political figures, such as the erstwhile PM Manmohan Singh and JMM head Shibu Soren, for standing by AAP during these challenging times. Emphasizing his deep-rooted connection with Delhi, Kejriwal stated that the citizens' affection for him remains unswaved, despite continuous criticism from BJP leaders. Condemning the bill's endorsement as a blatant overreach, Kejriwal opined that the BJP's central governance isn't acting in the nation's best interests but rather suppressing its citizens.

Punjab students Left in Limbo as Canadian College Cancels Admissions

Leaving students stranded in uncertainty, Canada's Northern College, Scarborough campus, has taken an unexpected decision that has caught numerous Indian students off guard, particularly those from Punjab.

Just weeks before the eagerly awaited September session, the college blindsided students by abruptly scrapping admissions, plunging them into uncertainty. Many of these students had already poured resources into



securing accommodations, for this unprecedented step was purchasing airfare, and getting ready for their imminent voyage to Canada. The reason





Policy rate to balance growth and inflation

he Reserve Bank of India's (RBI) recent decision, steered by its Monetary Policy Committee (MPC), to maintain its policy rate is a strategic gamble. This move is particularly intriguing when juxtaposed against the MPC's upward revision of its inflation forecast. A mere two months ago, the MPC projected a 5.1% average inflation based on the Consumer Price Index for the fiscal year ending in March 2024. This forecast has now been adjusted upwards by 30 basis points to 5.4%. A significant factor in this revision was the unexpected surge in tomato prices, which propelled the inflation projection for the July-September quarter up by a notable 100 basis points to 6.2%. RBI Governor Shaktikanta Das recognized the transient nature of such price shocks but also cautioned against the potential destabilization of inflation expectations due to recurrent food price fluctuations. While the RBI rightly emphasizes the government's role in timely supply-side interventions to mitigate such shocks, it's undeniable that unchecked price instability can jeopardize macroeconomic stability and growth. The MPC's commitment to a 4% inflation target is evident in its majority-backed policy stance, which emphasizes the gradual withdrawal of accommodation. In alignment with the MPC's position, the RBI has temporarily mandated a 10% hike in the cash reserve ratio for banks. This move aims to absorb some of the excess liquidity in the banking system, which could otherwise fuel inflation. Das has assured a review of this increase by September 8, if not sooner, to maintain liquidity during the festive season. However, the MPC acknowledges potential inflation risks, including erratic rainfall, rising crude oil prices, and anticipated output price increases. While the RBI and the MPC have expressed their readiness to align inflation targets and anchor inflation expectations, their proactive intervention in the upcoming months will be the real test of their commitment to stabilizing the economy.

India's Myanmar dilemma

uly 31 and August 1 will be recorded as the crucial dates when the history of Myanmar's ongoing tragedy was written. In the first case, the acting President of Myanmar, Mvint Swe, announced the fourth extension of the 'emergency' for another six months, which is in violation of the 2008 Constitution. In the second instance, the military regime decided to release several political prisoners and even reduced the sentences imposed on Daw Aung San Suu Kyi and the deposed President Win Myint. Ms. Suu Kyi was also moved out of prison to house arrest. However, these developments do not signal the dawn of a democratic and peaceful Myanmar.

Emergency and elections

The extension of the emergency further delays the elections proposed by the military. Min Aung Hlaing, the coup orchestrator, justified the extension due to the failure to establish 'normalcy' in large parts of the country. However, it is this pursuit of 'normalcy' that has resulted in suffering, with ACLED, or the Armed Conflict Location & Event Data Project (a disaggregated data collection, analysis, and crisis mapping project) reporting that Myanmar civilians witness two and a half times more violence than those in Afghanistan.

The military regime's relentless campaign includes an average of over 30 airstrikes per month in 2023. Surprisingly, the Tatmadaw (the military of Myanmar) exerts real control in only 30 percent-40 percent of the territory, as in admissions from the Burmese military and a report of the Special Advisory Council for Myanmar (SAC-M). A factitious national election would lead to the loss of further credibility if it is conducted only in a third of the country.

Moreover, the reshuffling within the military-backed Union Solidarity and Development Party (USDP) under Khin



Yi, is aimed at adding more military hardliners, further raising concerns about the junta's commitment to democracy. The decision by the National League for Democracy decision not to participate in the new elections, combined with the exclusion of smaller parties through the new party registration laws, leaves no viable opposition to the USDP in a parliament whose constitutional structure gives the military a practical veto.

The junta's decision to reduce Ms. Suu Kyi's sentence and shift her from the prison is a move that has perplexed a few. Yet, it is not a step towards democracy. Despite being the Tatmadaw's biggest rival, Ms. Suu Kyi has demonstrated a willingness to compromise and work with the military. She remains the rallying point for political change in Myanmar despite international criticism over her position/stand and role in the Rohingya persecution. Some protest may ease with these symbolic gestures. But more importantly, Suu Kyi's return could potentially split the National Unity Government NUG)-led resistance. A young generation of activists is leading the NUG and its cooperation with ethnic armed organisations and even reconciliation with

Rohingyas. This could all change if Ms. Suu Kyi is back in active politics.

These symbolic gestures by the junta, as said, may ease some protests and allow the military to claim progress over international and regional appeals, possibly leading to a lifting of sanctions and revived economic prospects. Additionally, they offer political bandwidth and a facesaving token to actors engaging with the junta, such as India.

Indian policy

At the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic and the coup, India took a proactive approach by providing food and vaccine assistance. However, the plight of the Myanmarese people seems to have faded from memory, with accusations of instigating violence in Manipur replacing it. Communities along the border have already defied the Home Ministry by providing shelter to the refugees. Concerns over trafficking and drug smuggling in Myanmar led to India suspending the Free Movement Regime in September 2022. India's External Affairs Minister S. Jaishankar raised the issue of infrastructure projects and stability in border areas with his Myanmar counterpart Than Swe in

Bangkok in July, on the sidelines of the Mekong Ganga Cooperation (MGC) meeting. India has also supported the Association of Southeast Asian Nations' 'Five-Point Consensus'. Nevertheless, India's policy towards Myanmar presents a paradox.

India's official rhetoric on commitment to democracy in Myanmar is in contrast with its policy framed through the lens of its security concerns in north-east India and relations with China. For example, India's announcement of the Sairang-Hmawngbuchhuah railway project near the Myanmar border, under India's Act East Policy, aims to counter China's railway access in Myanmar through Yunnan and the ambitious China-Myanmar Economic Corridor.

Disturbingly, sources such as Justice for Myanmar, SAC-M, and the United Nations Special Rapporteur have reported an increase in India's arms supply to the military since the coup. Arming the Tatmadaw not only undermines India's position on restoring democracy but also adds fuel to the fire, which spills over regularly across the border.

An approach to pursue

India's policy options in Myanmar are challenging, but not limited. The relaxation of Ms. Suu Kyi's prison sentence may provide an opportunity for India to engage with her and pro-democracy actors, including the NUG. Additionally, the government and media must avoid blanket securitisation and profiling of incoming refugees, many of whom have ties of kinship in India. This approach is essential to prevent further violence and foster an environment of care and compassion.

PRABHASH RANJAN EXPLAINS WHY UNIVERSAL BAN ON CLUSTER BOMBS NEEDED, AS PER CONVENTION GUIDELINES Time to stop the fence-sitting in cluster bomb use

ne decision by the United States to send cluster munitions to Ukraine, as part of a new military aid package to bolster Kyiv's war efforts against Russia, has raked up controversy. Cluster munitions, or cluster bombs, are weapons that release multiple explosive submunitions, also called bomblets, into the air. These submunitions explode as soon as they hit the ground, killing and maiming people in the area. Many bomblets do not blow up instantly and remain dormant for years (also known as the dud rate). These inactive bomblets act as precarious landmines, posing a grave threat to the civilian population, including women and children for a long t According to the Human Rights Watch, which is a civil society organisation, Russia, since launching a full-scale invasion of Ukraine, has used cluster bombs against Ukraine in cities such as Kharkiv, resulting in hundreds of civilian deaths and damaging civilian objects such as homes, hospitals, and schools. Now, Ukraine using these dangerous weapons will worsen the situation. Cluster bombs have a notorious history. They were used in the Second World War. Since then, cluster bombs have been used on multiple occasions including by the U.S. in the wars in Vietnam, Afghanistan, and Iraq. According to the Cluster Munition Monitor, anywhere between 56,000 to 86,000 people have died in cluster munition-affected countries, since the 1960s.



Article 1 of the CCM bans the use, production, stockpiling, and transfer of cluster bombs. The convention further obligates countries to destroy existing stockpile of cluster munitions in their possession. Countries are also legally bound to develop a victim assistance programme to provide support and rehabilitation to the cluster bomb victims in their jurisdiction.

Customary international law

Given that there is such an international treaty, are Russia and Ukraine violating international law by using cluster bombs? Since these countries are not signatories to the CCM, it is argued that they are not bound by international law banning cluster bombs. Another fundamental international humanitarian law norm relevant here is proportionality. Codified in Article 51(5) of the Additional Protocol I to the 1949 Geneva Conventions, this rule prohibits excessive use of force that causes incidental damage to the civilian population or civilian objects, when compared to military benefits anticipated. Given the fact that the use of cluster bombs is inherently indiscriminate, harming civilians, their use will amount to disproportionate use of force and is thus illegal. In sum, even if Russia and Ukraine are not signatories to the CCM, their use of cluster bombs violates international law.

But what about the U.S.? Arguably supplyng cluster bombs to Ukraine outside of the

Enactment of convention

Along with its increasing use, the international campaign against cluster bombs led by the civil society organisations such as Human Rights Watch also gathered momentum. This resulted in an international treaty called the Convention on Cluster Munitions (CCM) being enacted in May 2008. The enactment of the CCM has been a major step in eradicating cluster bombs. However, the treaty is not universal 112 countries have acceded to the CCM including many North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO) members such as Canada, Germany, France, and the United Kingdom. But important countries such as the U.S., Russia, China, Israel, and India have not signed the CCM. Ukraine is not a member.

This is not correct.

International law on armed conflicts has always drawn a distinction between combatants and civilian populations and between civilian objects and military objectives. In this regard, a fundamental customary international law (CIL) norm applicable to armed conflicts is the prohibition of indiscriminate attacks. In other words, an essential canon of international law is that the use of force must be discriminate, that is, the force should target specific military objectives and not civilians. This CIL norm is codified in Article 51(4) of Additional Protocol I to the 1949 Geneva Conventions, to which both Russia and Ukraine are parties. Given the nature of cluster bombs, their usage is a classic example of indiscriminate use of force that fails to differentiate between combatants and civilians, or between civilian objects and military objectives, and is thus illegal.

CCM, that Washington has not signed, is not a violation of international law. Moreover, it is claimed that the U.S.-made cluster bombs, unlike the Russian ones, have a low dud rate, that is, the prospects of unexploded bomblets are slim. Thus, questionably, they meet the requirements of the use of force being proportional and discriminate. Nonetheless, supplying cluster bombs to any country is an irresponsible act. The usage and the possession and transfer or supply of cluster bombs should be banned universally, as envisaged in the CCM. For this to happen, all United Nations member-countries should accede to the CCM and eradicate cluster bombs from the face of the earth.

"It is shocking to learn that the Central government, after considering the final findings of the designated authority, has decided not to accept the aforesaid recommendations," Arora said. He pointed out that the Indian textile industry contributes to 40 per cent of the country's demand for manmade fibres.

The spinning industry employs more than 6.5 lakh powerloom machines weaving three crore metres of cloth a day, and a yearly consumption of over 6 lakh metric tons of various yarns and fibres.

The MP said that the government's decision of not imposing definitive antidumping duty on imports of "Polyester Yarn (Polyester Spun Yarn)" originating in or exported from China PR, Indonesia, Nepal and Vietnam has cast a shadow on the domestic weaving sector which is mainly dependent of various types of synthetic yarns. 

NEW DELHI: Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman on August 10 said that from being declared a fragile economy in 2013, India is now among the fastest growing economies in the world with real GDP growth being 7.2 per cent in 2022-23. which is expected to expand by 6.5 per cent in the current financial year.

Participating in the discussion on the no-confidence motion in the Lok Sabha, the finance minister said India's growth is in stark contrast to the deceleration being seen in the global economy. Sitharaman observed that within nine years, the Indian economy has risen and experienced substantial economic growth, largely due to the government's policies, despite the Covid pandemic.

NEW DELHI: The Economic Offence Wing (EOW) of Odisha police has unearthed a pan-India crypto currencybased Ponzi scam involving money of more than Rs 1000 crore, a police official said on Monday

The EOW has arrested the head of STA Crypto Token namely Gurtej Sigh Sidhu (40), from Sri-Ganganagar, Rajasthan and its Odisha unit head Nirod Das. Sidhu is a native of Faridkot, Punjab and Nirod belongs to Bhadrak district of Odisha.

Sidhu was frequently changing his location in places like Goa, Lonavala, Mumbai, Delhi, Faridkot, Bhatinda, Hanumangadh and Sri Ganganagar. A team of EOW led by DSP Sasmita Sahoo was tracking his movement and finally able to arrest him, said an EOW official.

Acting on an intelligence input that a crypto currency-based Ponzi scam is being run in Odisha especially in Bhadrak, Balasore, Bhubaneswar, Mayurbhanj, Jajpur, Kendrapada and Keonjhar districts, the EOW has conducted an enquiry.

During the investigation, the EOW found that STA through some upline members are very active in these districts and they have been using various propaganda tools to persuade people to join in this scheme and earn huge money in a very short time.

The members have started using the STA Token like a legal tender in their day to day business. It is estimated that more than 10, 000 people from Odisha have already been members of this scheme. This Ponzi scheme has more than 2 lakh members (Pan India) mainly in the states like Punjab, Rajasthan, Bihar, Jharkhand, Haryana, Delhi, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Odisha and Assam, the

official informed. STA (Solar Techno Alliance) was launched in September 2021. In its website & social media accounts it claims to be a one stop solar technologies service.

Though STA is not authorized by RBI or any other authorities to collect deposits, it runs a huge Ponzi (Pyramid) scheme in the garb of crypto tokens. The firm uses the socially popular terms like green energy, solar technology etc. to mask its cryptoonzi scam.

The STA website is hosted from Iceland but its business and activity is limited to India only and it is headed by one David Gez, a young Hungarian (Europe) national who has visited India multiple times. According to the EOW, both

David and Gurtej Sidhu have travelled to many places in India including Odisha and have attended various STA programs. They are always seen using luxurious lifestyles like star hotels, expensive cars, fancy clothes, surrounded by bouncers, hero's welcome in meetings etc.

The Ponzi firm conducts several publicity programs at various places to spread its membership. They use fancy hotels, motivational speakers, music, lunch/dinner etc. in such meetings to brainwash future members.

2103 dead beneficiaries, Rs 2.8 cr diverted for publicity: CAG

NEW DELHI: The Ministry of Rural Development (MORD) made payment of pensions amounting Rs 2 crore to 2, 103 National Social Assistance Programme (NSAP) beneficiaries in 26 states and Union Territories even after their death, and funds worth Rs 2.83 crore were diverted for publicity and campaign, the Comptroller Auditor General of India (CAG)

has said in its report. The CAG report, on the performance audit of the NSAP from 2017-18 to 2020-21, was tabled in the Lok Sabha on Tuesday. The report said that according to NSAP guidelines, a pensioner's pension may be discontinued due to death or migration or crossing BPL or any other reason and the pension payment should be stopped accordingly

The information was revealed by the new court documents unsealed on Wednesday, reports The Verge.

The warrant was issued as part of a Department of Justice special investigation.

In January, as part of his inquiry into Trump's role in interfering with the orderly transition of power following the 2020 election, special counsel Jack Smith obtained a search warrant for the former President's Twitter account, @realDonaldTrump.

The objection came four days after the court-mandated deadline and asked the district court to determine if the nondisclosure was legal before handing over the warrant's requested material.

Islamabad HC orders Attock jail officials to allow lawyers to meet Pak ex-PM Imran

ISLAMABAD: The Islamabad High Court ruled on Friday that the lawyers of Imran Khan can meet the former Pakistan prime minister in Attock prison where he has been incarcerated after his conviction in a corruption case. The ruling came after Khan's lawyer Sher Afzal Khan Marwat appeared before Chief Justice Aamer Farooq and requested him to issue directives to allow the legal team access to Khan jailed since Saturday in the Punjab province.

Marawat said the lawyers were not permitted to meet the 70-year-old Pakistan Tehreeke-Insaf (PTI) Chairman despite the court orders, the Express Tribune newspaper reported.

He said "false accusations" of causing disruptions in the jail were levelled against Khan's lawyers, it said.

"We have said this before and we will say it again, lawyers are allowed to hold meetings," the chief justice said. "Failure to allow these meetings will be viewed as contempt of court,' he warned. The court also heard Khan's plea requesting a transfer from Attock district prison to Rawalpindi's high-security

Adiala jail, the report said.

"There is the matter of meetings and facilities at the jail before us. We will issue appropriate orders," Chief Justice Farooq said. On Thursday, Khan's wife Bushra Bibi was allowed to meet her husband for the first time since the former premier was put behind bars on Saturday, while his legal team was stopped from having a meeting with Khan.

Bushra met Khan after the Islamabad High Court (IHC) granted her permission, said



Khan's lawyer Naeem Haider Panjutha. Panjuthaha was granted access on Monday by the jail authorities to meet Khan, but was denied permission on Thursday. After seeing the PTI chairman, he had said that the former premier was being kept in "distressing" conditions and provided "C-Class jail facilities". Attock prison in eastern Punjab province is infamous for its harsh conditions and its inmates include convicted militants.

Khan has told his lawyers to take him out of the Attock jail as he does not want to remain in a small, isolated cell without national monument to block new mining air-conditioning that is infested with flies during the day and insects at night. His party has approached the Islamabad High Court (IHC) and sought Khan's transfer from Attock prison to Adiala jail in the garrison city of Rawalpindi. Khan, the cricketer-turned-politician,

was arrested on Saturday from his Lahore house shortly after an Islamabad trial court found him guilty of "corrupt practices" in the Toshakhana corruption case. He was sentenced on charg-

es of unlawfully selling state gifts acquired by him and his family during his 2018-2022 tenure.

Khan has also been barred from politics for five years, preventing him from contesting an upcoming election. He has denied any wrongdoing.


