### Wheat procurement season begins in Punjab World Bank Forecasts Robust 7.5% Growth for Indian Economy in 2024 CHANDIGARH: The Rabi Marketing Season (RMS)

2024-25 began from April 1 in the State and would last till May 31st, 2024.

Disclosing this, the Secretary, Food, Civil Supplies & **Consumer Affairs Department** Vikas Garg said that in the State, a total of 1908 regular procurement centers have been declared as mandi yards and allottment of procurement centers made between all the procurement agencies. In order to ensure uninterrupted procurement operations, temporary procurement centers are also being opened.

The procurement agencies of State needed the Cash Credit Limit (CCL) of Rs. 30, 776 crore with a view to procure due share of wheat (115.50 Lakh Metric Tonnes). In this regard, CCL worth Rs. 27077.91 crore, for procuring wheat in April, has been received while the rest of CCL would be received in the

economy is projected to grow at a stellar 7.5 per cent rate in the fiscal year 2023/24, according to the latest World Bank report.

This robust expansion makes India a key driver of growth in the South Asian region

Crediting India's vibrant services and industrial sectors, the World Bank expects the nation's economic output to moderate to 6.6 per cent in 2024/25 before picking up again.

A decade-long focus on public investment is expected to yield dividends over the medium term.

"Output growth is projected to reach 7.5 per cent in FY2023/24 on the back of robust growth in Q3," stated the World Bank report.

It highlighted robust hiring, surging manufacturing activity and new export orders as positive factors. While inflation has largely



remained within the Reserve Bank's 2-6 per cent target range, the World Bank forecasts easing price pressures ahead, allowing more policy flexibility.

The government's fiscal deficit and debt levels are also projected to decline, aided by growth and consolidation efforts. Overall, South Asia is

pegged as the fastest-growing emerging market region for 2024-25, thanks to India's resilient economy. However, climate shocks and debt burdens pose risks to long-term stability.

The report recommends policies focused on boosting private investment and job creation to build more resilient growth across the region.

# **RBI to release Fintech Self-Regulatory Body framework by April end**

**MUMBAI:** The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) will unveil the framework for a self-regulatory organisation (SRO) for the fintech sector by the end of April 2024, Governor Shaktikanta Das announced in the post-monetary policy press conference.

The move aims to operationalise one SRO for fintechs by the time of the Global Fintech Festival in September 2024.

«As I had mentioned in last year>s GFF, we would like one SRO relating to fintech to be operational. We are working towards that,» Das stated. Deputy Governor T

**NEW DELHI:** India's foreign exchange reserves have achieved a new milestone, climbing to an all-time high of USD 642.631 billion during last week of March, according to data released by the Reserve Bank of India (RBI). This represents an increase of USD 140 million over the previous week's total.

The latest surge marks the fifth consecutive week of growth in India's overall forex reserves. In the previous reporting week, the reserves had witnessed a substantial jump of USD 6.396 billion.

# Wrestlers' sexual harassment: Delhi court reserves order on framing charges

**NEW DELHI:** A Delhi court on Thursday reserved its order on framing of charges against BJP MP and former Wrestling Federation of India (WFI) chief, Brij Bhushan Sharan Singh, in an alleged sexual harassment case by six women wrestlers, for April 18.

In February, Brij Bhushan Sharan Singh had sought to be discharged in the case, citing delay in reporting the alleged offence and contradictions in the complainants' statements.

Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Priyanka Raipoot, of Rouse Avenue Court on Thursday heard the arguments presented by the complainants, Delhi Police, and the accused, including Vinod Tomar, former Assistant Secretary of WFI. Earlier during the proceedings, the complainants and police had said that there was ample evidence to proceed with the trial

against the accused individuals. The Delhi Police had refuted the argument of the accused



that certain incidents occurred overseas and thus fell outside the jurisdiction of Delhi courts,

contending that the alleged acts of sexual harassment, attributed to Brij Bhushan Sharan Singh, both abroad and in India, including Delhi, constituted part of the same offence. His counsel had told the court that the incidents were said to have occurred in 2012 but were only reported to the police in 2023.

In addition, he had contended discrepancies in the timing and locations of the alleged incidents, asserting no clear link between them. The defence had pointed out contradictions between the complainants' affidavits and statements.

cluded its arguments last month. It was contended that incidents of alleged sexual harassment, whether occurring overseas or within the country, were interconnected and part of the same transaction. Hence, the police had said that the court had jurisdiction to hear the case.

Additional Public Prosecutor Atul Srivastava, representing the Delhi Police, had argued that under Section 354 of the IPC. the case is not time-barred, as it carries a maximum punishment

claims to have some documents that "shed light on how India's foreign intelligence agency allegedly carried out operations to eliminate the individuals abroad". The report says that India carried out these operations "as part of an emboldened approach to national security after 2019". The report comes amid allegations that India is targeting individuals whom it considers hostile to it.

According to the report, the fresh claims relate to almost 20 killings since 2020 which have been carried out by unknown gunmen in Pakistan. 'The Guardian' report says, While India has previously been unofficially linked to the deaths, this is the first time Indian intelligence personnel have discussed the alleged operations in Pakistan, and detailed documentation has been seen alleging RAW's direct involvement in the assassinations".

The fresh allegations refer to those charged with violent terror offences. When Muhammad Riaz and Shahid Latif were gunned down in 2023 on Pakistan soil, Islamabad had accused India's intelligence agency of being behind the killings.

New Delhi was then quick to dismiss the allegations, calling them "malicious anti-India propaganda". Referring to the details shared by the Pakistani investigators, the Londonbased newspaper said that "these deaths were orchestrated by Indian intelligence sleeper cells, mostly operating out of the United Arab Emirates". The rise in killings in 2023 was credited to the increased activity of these cells, which are accused of paying millions of rupees to local criminals or poor Pakistanis to carry out the assassinations.<sup>3</sup>

According to the report, "Indian agents also allegedly recruited jihadists to carry out the shootings." Similarly, the report says quoting two Indian intelligence officers that the spy agency's action was triggered by the Pulwama attack in 2019, which was perpetrated by the Pakistan-based terror group Jaish-e-Mohammed.

The report also says that "after Pulwama, the approach changed to target the elements outside the country before they are able to launch an attack or create any disturbance". Quoting one Indian intelligence operative, the report says, "We could not stop the attacks because ultimately their safe havens were in Pakistan, so we had to get to the source." The Guardian also says that in response to its queries, the Ministry of External Affairs denied all the allegations, reiterating an earlier statement that they were "false and malicious anti-India propaganda".

The ministry emphasised a previous denial made by External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar that targeted killings in other countries were "not the government of India's policy".

According to the report, an RAW handler allegedly paid for information on Zahid Akhund, an alias for the convicted Kashmiri terrorist Zahoor Mistry who was involved in the hijacking of an Air India flight.

"Millions of rupees were then allegedly paid to Afghan nationals to carry out the shooting in Karachi in March 2022. They fled over the border but their handlers were later arrested by Pakistani security agencies, says the report. Jaish-e-Mohammed commander Shahid Latif was killed on Pakistan soil.

In this session held in the presence of Sri Guru Granth Sahib at the Teja Singh Samari Hall in the SGPC office, SGPC general secretary Bhai Rajinder Singh Mehta presented the budget, which was approved by the members amid the resonance of Sikh victory slogans. 



MUMBAI: The Reserve Bank of India on Friday decided to keep policy rate unchanged for the seventh time in a row and said that it remains vigilant towards upside risks to food inflation.

The rate increase cycle was paused in April last year after six consecutive rate hikes aggregating to 250 basis points since May 2022.

Announcing the first bimonthly monetary policy for the current financial year, RBI Governor Shaktikanta Das said the Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) has decided to keep the reporate unchanged at 6.5 per cent. He said MPC will remain

# GST collections hit Rs 1.78 highest since roll-out

NEW DELHI: GST collections in March grew 11.5 % to Rs 1.78 lakh crore on higher domestic sales, the finance ministry said on Monday.

The gross GST collection for the last fiscal (April 2023-March 2024) stood at Rs 20.18 lakh crore, 11.7 per cent higher than the mop-up in the preceding fiscal.

The average monthly gross collection for FY24 stood at Rs 1.68 lakh crore, exceeding Rs 1.5 lakh crore in the preceding fiscal.

Gross Good and Services Tax (GST) revenue for March 2024 witnessed the second highest collection ever at Rs 1.78 lakh crore, with a 11.5 per cent year-on-year growth. This surge was driven by a significant rise in GST collection from domestic transactions at 17.6 per cent," the ministry said in a statement.

The highest-ever GST col-



lection was recorded at Rs 1.87 lakh crore in April 2023.

Experts said the doubledigit increase in monthly GŠT collection underscores the resilience of economy and paves way for next generation GST reforms.

The ministry said GST collections have shown "strong was Rs 3.76 lakh crore, State consistent performance" in 2023-24 and the fiscal ended March 31 marks a "milestone" with total gross GST collection crore collected on imported of Rs 20.18 lakh crore, a 11.7

per cent increase compared to the previous year.

GST revenue net of refunds as of March 2024 is Rs 18.01 lakh crore, which is a growth of 13.4 per cent over the same period a year ago.

**NEW DELHI:** Gold prices surged by Rs 850 to reach a new peak of Rs 70,050 per 10 grams on Thursday on strong global cues, accord-ing to HDFC Securities.

This is the second straight session that precious metal prices have hit all-time high levels. In the previous trade, the precious metal had settled at Rs 69,200 per 10 grams. Silver prices also zoomed Rs 1,000 to hit record Rs 81,700 per kg. In the previous session, it had finished at Rs 80,700 per kg.

"Spot gold prices (24 carat) in the Delhi markets are trading at Rs 70,050 per 10 grams, up by Rs 850, amid a bullish trend in the overseas markets," Saumil Gandhi, Senior Analyst of Commodities at HDFC Securities, said.

# **CAMPAIGN AGAINST BLACK MONEY RUNS COUNTER TO THE SCHEME THAT LACKS TRANSPARENCY**

Will Santiago Martin, the 'Lottery King', play the spoiler in the

unfolding drama of electoral bonds? Is the State Bank of India (SBI) playing ball with those in authority over the disclosure of the unique alphanumeric code numbers on the bonds that will identify those who benefit?

The Supreme Court has not permitted any latitude to the SBI, which had sought time till June to disclose particulars of the bond purchasers and recipients. According to reports, the Enforcement Directorate (ED) launched a probe against Martin's Future Gaming and Hotel Services in 2019. In October that year, he purchased electoral bonds worth

Rs 190 crore. His total purchases touched Rs 1,368 crore. Why did the 'Lottery King' have to keep political parties indebted to him? Martin's firm is the biggest purchaser of electoral bonds. The biggest chunk of these bonds went to MK Stalin's DMK. What did he hope to gain?

Bans on betting only increase the contours of corruption. It will be more beneficial to regulate betting, like the UK has done. Donations by corporate houses to political parties are a necessity. In fact, every business house has to donate. If it fails to do so, the visits by myriad inspectors, who make a good living by inspecting, will not only be more frequent but also much more 'expensive'. Business houses are geared up to face these inspectors. Some hire officials especially to 'look after' the inspectors. But the gaming outlets that have multiplied in recent years are a different kettle of fish. It would be better for the

citizens if their rulers stopped moralising about the vice of gambling and allowed it to surface on the open ground. Policemen who routinely shut their eyes to this 'social evil' and the politicians who extract their pound of flesh from the illegal operators will lose

out, but the public will benefit in the long run. The government will rake in the taxes. On cricket betting alone, the government will be able to feed the millions now existing on 5 kg of rice or wheat which the government doles out every month. The statistics put out by the government show that nearly 60 per cent of the country's people live on such doles. Incidentally, these statistics contradict assertions made by the government that poverty in India is on the decline. But we are now accustomed to fake and contradictory news items.

Shah and his colleagues in the BJP's senior ranks are understandably unhappy with the revelations now emerging about the journey of the electoral bonds. They need not bother. Most educated people had already suspected the truth. The less educated and less affluent just do not care. They have become Modi bhakts because of the power of our PM's rhetoric and the overpowering cult figure that his propaganda machine has created. The third term is his for the asking. It's time for him to change gears and concentrate on 'credibility' as a more acceptable keeper of his legacy.

The role of the Competition Commission of India (CCI) in specified cases has become critical. 

crore, respectively. Additionally, the government raised Rs 858 crore through the initial public offering (IPO) of the Indian Renewable Energy Development Agency (IREDA). Instead, under the capital receipts heading, the govern-ment estimated to collect Rs 30,000 crore, which officials clarified included Rs 20,000 crore from disinvestment and Rs 10,000 crore from asset monetisation.

According to data from the Department of Investment and Public Asset Management (DIPAM), the actual collections for FY24 through OFS and share sales to employees stood at Rs 16,507.29 crore as of March 31, 2024, falling short of the revised estimate. Historically, the govern-

ment has struggled to meet its disinvestment targets set in budgets, with the exceptions of the 2018-19 and 2017-18 financial years. The highestever disinvestment mop-up was recorded in 2017-18 at Rs 1,00,056 crore, marginally exceeding the budget target of Rs 1 lakh crore.

# India's economy is at risk amidst fiscal strains

he Centre's fiscal deficit's sharp ascent from Rs 11 lakh crore in January to Rs 15 lakh crore by the end of February paints a concerning picture of India's economic stewardship. This leap, marking the deficit at 86.5% of the revised Rs 17.3 lakh crore target within a mere 29 days, starkly contrasts last year's smoother progression. Such a spike in deficit not only mirrors fiscal stress but also raises questions about the government's budgetary discipline and economic forecasting. Two factors partially mitigate this abrupt rise. Firstly, an increased allocation to States via tax devolution shares, and secondly, a significant boost in capital expenditure in February. These expenditures, while necessary, underscore the urgent need for balanced fiscal management. Especially when aiming to meet an ambitious Rs 10 lakh crore capex target amidst constraints like the Model Code of Conduct for the looming Lok Sabha polls. Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman's adjustment of this fiscal year's deficit target to 5.8% from 5.9% in the interim Budget, alongside a commitment to narrow the deficit to 4.5% of GDP by 2025-26, suggests an awareness of the need for fiscal prudence. However, achieving these targets amidst the dual challenges of stimulating growth post-CO-VID-19 and managing high inflation, potential agricultural setbacks, and uneven consumption demands, will require more than mere fiscal gymnastics. With significant unspent funds still earmarked for critical sectors such as Agriculture, Rural Development, and Consumer Affairs as the fiscal year ends, there's a real risk that underspending could impact the effectiveness of government programs. This scenario underlines the importance of not just fiscal tightening but also improving budgetary execution to ensure that allocated funds effectively reach intended sectors and initiatives. As the country stands at a fiscal crossroads, the path ahead demands recalibrating strategies to align with economic realities and priorities.

# ARUNA BHATTACHARYA BELIEVES EARLY DIAGNOSIS AND ACCESSIBLE TREATMENT CAN TRANSFORM INDIA'S TB WOES TB still kills thousands daily


very day, 3,500 people worldwide lose their lives to tuberculosis (TB), and around 30,000 people become infected with TB bacilli, according to World Health Organization (WHO) estimates. India alone accounts for 27% of global TB cases. This is jarring, given that TB is a detectable and curable disease and TB diagnosis and treatment protocols have been a part of existing health systems for a long time.

World TB Day, on March 24, commemorates Dr. Robert Koch's discovery of Mycobacterium tuberculosis (the bacteria that causes tuberculosis) in 1882. Despite its discovery then, possible treatments using streptomycin in 1943 and the discovery of antibiotics such as isoniazid and rifampicin in the 1950s and 1960s, the war against the pathogen is far from been won, and there are multiple challenges to be overcome in combating the disease.

India remains a TB hotspot. The TB control programme in India has undergone several changes since its inception in 1962, incorporating evidence from various do-mains of public health and health systems, including pharmacology, microbiology, epidemiology, the social sciences, and information technology. The theme for World TB Day 2024

(March 24), 'Yes! We can end TB!', underscores the potential to eradicate TB with existing disease control mechanisms, infrastructure, training, and the political will. Yet, TB in its various avatars — drugresistant (DR-TB), totally drug-resistant (TDR-TB), extensively drug-resistant (XDR-TB), pulmonary TB (P-TB) and non-pulmonary TB — seep out, akin to trying to hold sand in one's hand, only to have it slip through one's fingers.

We are in an era of hope where public health discourse has gained importance and technology has narrowed the gaps that were previously unimaginable. The COVID-19 pandemic, despite its disruptive and uncertain nature, has brought to the



fore preventive aspects of public health, highlighting social determinants of health in the scheme of things. Despite the passage of World TB Day 2024, looking at rapid urbanisation, migration, and the stresses on the existing health systems, I propose a 10-point agenda towards 'ending TB'.

First, early detection. Given TB's aetiology, early detection is the key. Symptoms are often ignored and mistaken for other common ailments, leading to delays in reporting. Compulsory screening for family and contacts of each index case is essential, necessitating availability of laboratory facilities and efficient follow-up mechanisms within health systems. Second, precise treatment categorisation. With increasing DR-TB, it is imperative to know the resistance status at the time of diagnosis to assign appropriate treatment regimens as per their phenotypic susceptibility.

Third, treatment adherence and followup. Unlike other bacterial diseases, TB requires a long period of sustained treatment. Often, this leads to non-compliance, which could be due to observable improvement in health status, or change of residence, movement across States and districts. Even though the TB control programme has a built-in follow-up system, compliance to complete treatment is not 100%. Leveraging technology to monitor compliance needs focus

Fourth, zero mortality. Mitigating mortality due to TB, be it DR-TB or nonpulmonary TB, is necessary.

### Issue of drug resistance

Fifth, controlling drug resistance. Drug resistance in TB remains a man-made phenomenon. Unregulated use of antibiotics and non-compliance with treatment regimens lead to selective evolutionary pressure on the bacillus, in turn resulting in developing drug resistance. Poor regulatory mechanisms for drug control and non-compliance with treatment regimens are the main reasons for such a high degree of drug resistance.

Sixth, assessing the extent of drug-resistant TB. There needs to be data on the proportion of people diagnosed with TB who nave rifampicin-resistant TB (RR-TB) and multidrug-resistant TB (MDR-TB) - this is resistance to both rifampicin and isoniazid, collectively referred to as MDR/RR-TB. This helps in better plan and design of the control programme, resource allocation for diagnosis, the treatment regime as well as availability of trained staff mandated for DR-TB

Seventh, availability of appropriate medicines. Assured medical supply is mandated under the TB control programme. However, procurement challenges for DR-TB medications such as bedaquiline and delamanid

must be addressed, in addition to ascertaining treatment facilities for all DR-TB cases which require in-patient care.

Eighth, integration into larger health systems. Strengthening referral networks within and between different levels of public health systems and private health systems is vital to ensure no symptomatic cases are lost, no patients miss their dosages and are non-compliant, and, importantly, the screening of contacts for all positive cases of pulmonary TB cases (DR or non-DR).

Ninth, dynamic notification system. A robust notification system will ease the burden of health system personnel. While Ni-kshay has evolved — 'Ni-Kshay-(Ni=End, Kshay=TB) is the web enabled patient management system for TB control under the National Tuberculosis Elimination Programme (NTEP)' - it requires improvements to capture real-time TB data between sectors, practitioners, time, and locations.

Tenth, considering population mobility and migration. Often, the productive aspects of life are overlooked when discussing disease and health care seeking, particularly in the context of TB, which suffers from social and cultural stigma. Interestingly, once TB is diagnosed and positive cases are put on treatment, health is restored quickly for the patient to resume their daily activities. Therefore, portability of TB treatment within the country is crucial at the policy level. Let us pledge to create a TB-free India and world. With early diagnosis and continuous treatment accessible to all, we can achieve the goal of 'Yes! We have ended TB!'

# KABIR TANEJA EXPLAINS HOW BEIJING SHOWS CAUTION IN GEOPOLITICAL CONFLICTS China, a 'want-to-be' superpower, stays cautious

e first anniversary of the Chinabrokered détente between Saudi Arabia and Iran in March 2023 passed without much fanfare. The war in Gaza has enveloped almost all regional political and diplomatic capacities across the Persian Gulf, while also highlighting international actors and their core interests amidst this fallout. Beijing has taken a position that is clearly pro-Palestine, in line with its historical standing on the issue, alienating its relations with Israel.

However, in China's state-controlled media, Chinese President Xi Jinping's success in inging together Rivadh and ehran was highlighted as an institutional Chinese position to promote peace. In a glowing piece on the anniversary which quoted regional analysts who underscored a sense of fatigue with the West's 'conditional' relations, the Chinese media outlet Xinhua said, "Today, China's advocacy for peace still resonates with Middle East countries."

China seems content with predominantly displacing American hegemony without replacing it. Even a perception of being a 'soft hegemon' in the region will stand starkly against Chinese grandstanding against western policies. This is despite the fact that Beijing utilised the 'war on terror'-era to build closer ties with the U.S. and benefit its own security concerns regarding radicalisation and terrorism narratives around its restive injiang region. But once again all narrow geostrategic aims. Scholars Sheena Chestnut Greitens and Isaac Kardon have highlighted in their work on how China, for its partner states, is more about their internal security rather than external - that is, prioritising political security of regimes rather than states. Arguably, this could appropriately explain what formalised Chinese mediation would aim for. The war in Gaza colours Beijing as still being a 'want-to-be' superpower. Being risk averse and having a lack of alternatives to the historical West-centric policies (which it chides as being detrimental to global security and prosperity) makes Beijing stand out as hollow. Other than offering a sizeable cheque book, China still has few answers as substitutes to long-standing geopolitical flashpoints. For now, despite its size, it remains a utilitarian superpower for others to hedge against rather than being an upcoming traditional superpower.

### China's absence in the Red Sea crisis

The war in Gaza has drawn strong red lines between China and Israel. This raises interesting questions on the exact role Beijing played in the Saudi-Iran détente. The probability of China being pulled into the process by Riyadh and Tehran, rather than actively brokering a deal, remains high. China has also been absent through the crisis in the Red Sea, where predominantly western naval forces have attempted to maintain the free flow of trade in this critical waterway. Contrarily, reports have suggested that Yemen-based Houthis were not targeting Chinese and Russian ships, suggesting a bypass potentially using leverages that Beijing has with its close partner Iran despite Tehran's calls for the Yemeni militia to cease attacks. If so, it shows China's crafty diplomacy was to predominantly protect its own interests and not wade into the crisis as an influential power looking to use its position

A push towards 'mediation diplomacy' has been an aspirational design for China on two major fronts. First, it is to position itself as an antithesis to what Beijing sees as decades worth of western interventionist policies, specifically in a region such as West Asia, where conflict has direct correlation with colonial history. Second, it is to increase its own geopolitical weight as a responsible international actor and power. However, both these aims have been confronted by realities around the war in Gaza as China has taken a clear stance towards the Arab side and has not condemned Hamas by name. Much of the reasoning behind this is to counter long-standing American influence and to take advantage of crevasses in regional diplomacy, specifically by the likes of Saudi Arabia and the United Arab Emirates (UAE), which are looking to chart their own paths of strategic autonomy





Country's life expectancy hits historic record in 2023: Russian PM

Is Imran Khan's wife Bushra **Bibi being poisoned ? Medical** reports say 'no evidence'



ISLAMABAD: Amid allegations that Bushra Bibi, the spouse of Pakistan Tehreeke-Insaf (PTI) founder Imran Khan, was poisoned at Bani Gala sub-jail, personal physician Asim Yousuf confirmed conducting a medical examination, Geo News reported.

Dr Yousuf stated that no evidence of any poisonous substance being administered to the former first lady was found during the examination

"At this time, there is no evidence of Bushra Bibi being poisoned," Dr Yousuf said while speaking to Geo News, adding, "We are not conducting any medical tests to ascertain the administration of any poisonous substance to Bushra Bibi as no such symptoms are detected," as per Geo News. The physician stated that Bushra Bibi's health deteriorated after taking a meal two months ago. However, she started consuming less food due to health issues, he added.

According to Geo News, the physician added that he was unaware of her actual health issues, which happened two months ago

Yousuf said that medical tests should be conducted by keeping in view of her age and to check

for any health problems, including stomach-related issues Additionally, he said that

he would meet the incarcerated PTI founder on Saturday. Regarding Khan's health, Dr Yousuf confirmed that the former premier's condition had improved, noting that his appetite had not fully returned to normal following his recovery from a minor illness.

On Tuesday, incarcerated former prime minister Khan apprised the court that his wife was poisoned at the Bani Gala sub-jail.

The PTI founder claimed this during a hearing of the USD 190 million settlement case in Rawalpindi's Adiala jail. Khan informed the accountability court judge that the former first lady had marks on her skin and tongue after "being poisoned". He requested the court

order an inquiry into the incident and a comprehensive medical examination of Bushra Bibi.

Before her court appearance, the former first lady also asserted during her interaction with journalists that "three drops of toilet cleaner" were mixed in her food on the eve of Shab-e-Meraj.

Ambani at the age 66 is ranked 9th on the list with a wealth of USD 116 billion, up from USD 83.4 billion in the 2023 ranking

MUMBAI: Oil-to-telecom conglomerate Reliance Industries Ltd head Mukesh Ambani continues to be the richest Indian and has now broken into the world's top 10 wealthiest persons in the latest Forbes 2024 Billionaire List.

Ambani, 66, is ranked ninth on the list with a wealth of USD 116 billion, up from USD 83.4 billion in the 2023 ranking, according to Forbes.

Gautam Adani is the second richest Indian and is ranked at No. 17 on the global list. He is worth USD 84 billion, up from USD 47.2 billion in  $202\overline{3}$  when

his apples-to-airport conglomerate was rocked by a damning report by US short-seller Hindenburg Research. The Adani group has denied all allegations in the report.

Adani, 61, was worth USD 90 billion in the 2022 ranking. The Forbes 2024 Billionaires List features 2,781 individuals, an increase of 141 names from last year's list. The billionaires, than ever, worth USD 14.2 trillion in aggregate, up by USD 2 trillion from 2023 and USD 1.1 trillion above the previous record, also set in 2021.

Two-thirds of the list's members are worth more than a year

ago; only one-fourth are poorer. Fashion and cosmetics giant LVMH's Bernard Arnault is at the top of the list with USD 233 billion wealth, followed by Elon Musk with USD 195 billion and Amazon's Jeff Bezos with USD 194 billion.

Facebook founder Mark Zuckerberg comes next in the list with a net worth of USD 177 billion.

The US has a record 813 billionaires followed by China with 473 billionaires. India added 31



# Booming real estate results in higher recoveries of stressed assets ; trend visible in power, other sectors: Study

**NEW DELHI:** Recovery in key infrastructure sectors has cast a positive impact even on the stressed assets in these industries as is reflected in marked improvement in realisation of such assets in real estate, roads, power and steel, according to an ASSOCHAM-CRISIL Ratings study.

Recoveries in real estate topped the list, followed by the road sector thanks to several policy interventions, turnaround in these industries as also an overall positive macroeconomic. "Real estate is seen to recover 77-82 per of the acquired debt (by asset reconstruction companies) over eight years followed by highway tolling with a recovery of 58-63 per cent," the study noted.

As a result of high recoveries, the debt under the real estate sector is being bought at a very low discount amidst rising investor interest due to
