

NEW DELHI: India's economy must grow at a pace of 8-10 per cent per annum over the next ten years to fully capitalise on its favorable demographic dividend, according to the Reserve Bank of India (RBI).

In its latest monthly bulletin, released on Tuesday, the central bank emphasised that achieving India>s developmental aspirations through 2055 hinges on this elevated growth trajectory during the ongoing period of demographic dividend that commenced in 2018.

Conditions are ripe for India to extend its recent run of real GDP growth exceeding 8 per cent during 2021-24, the RBI noted. An SBI report projects India>s GDP growth for the current fiscal year to approach 8 per cent. However, the RBI cautions that India>s development strategy must laser-focus on maximising the contribution



of its young, expanding labor force to drive productivity gains. Leveraging this demographic bonus is critical for India to escape the middle-income trap. With the working-age popu-

"I want to tell the nation that for the first time in 1977, the discussion on EVMs had started. At that time, we were nowhere in politics. It was first used in 1982. We were not there even in 1988. The dignitaries at that time from this very House had approved it lawfully.

They had framed the law. Moreover, under the leadership of the Congress in 1992, all the rules related to the EVMs were made. Like they keep saying we did this, we did that'; this too was done by you. Now you have lost. Mamata Banerjee continues to fire salvos at Calcutta **HC** against ruling in school jobs case



KOLKATA: West Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee on Friday continued to fire salvos at a section of the judiciary in the Calcutta High Court over its recent ruling in the school jobs case even after the court on Thursday admitted a petition seeking action against the Trinamool chief for her 'anti-judiciary' remarks made in the past few days.

In a crucial ruling on Monav. the Calcutta H cancelled 25, 753 appointments in teaching and non-teaching posts made by the West Bengal School Service Commission (WBSSC) in 2016. The case is being probed by the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) and the Enforcement Directorate (ED). Addressing an election rally in West Midnapore district on Friday, the Chief Minister said, "The common people expect justice from the honourable court. There are many cases which have been pending for years. But whenever the BJP moves any PIL, they are bailed out. But the opposite happens when Trinamool files any petition." She also attacked a portion of the Calcutta High Court ruling that ordered the return of salaries along with interest drawn by those who were recruited illegally in 2016. "After ordering the cancellation of jobs of so many individuals, there was an order to return the salaries drawn along with an annualised interest of 12 per cent. I do not want to name anybody. But I want to ask that if they are also asked to return their salaries similarly, will they be able to do it? Is there anarchy in the state that so many jobs can be cancelled at one go," the Chief Minister asked.

NEW DELHI: A Delhi court on Thursday granted the Delhi Police a 30-day extension to complete its probe in the December 13, 2023 Parliament security breach case.

This is the second time that the court has given time to the Delhi Police Special Cell to conclude the probe. Earlier, in March, 45 days were granted, and now the extension is until May 25.

An application by the Delhi Police, who originally sought a 45-day extension to complete their probe, was moved before Delhi's Patiala House Courts.

Special public prosecutor Akhand Pratap Singh, representing the Delhi Police, stressed the necessity for the extension, citing pending reports and the need to question witnesses, including those from Parliament, before



finalising the charge sheet. All the six accused persons were also presented before the court as their judicial custody ended. The court extended their custody till May 25, allowing the police additional time to complete its investigation.

Woman prisoner alleges rape in police van outside PGIMS Rohtak

The woman undergoing imprisonment in a case of drug trafficking registered under NDPS Act, who earlier had also attempted to commit suicide inside the jail, alleged gang raped by two youth prisoners sitting in the same police van when it was parked outside the PGIMS Rohtak. The three prisoners, including the woman, were brought to Rohtak from Jind in a prisoner van for medical examination. Both youths were arrested by the police in rape and murder cases, undergoing 20 years sentence by the court in each case

In a complaint lodged with the police, the woman of age arounf 42 alleged that the other prisoners, including Manish and Satish, gave her a soft-drink laced with some sedative and raped her when she lost sense completely in the van, while the police team accompanying them had gone to complete some paper work formalities and the female was gangraped by them, as alleged by her However, the Jind police registered a Zero FIR on the basis of the complaint lodged by the rape victim woman and sent it to Rohtak police station for investigation.

BENGALURU: Criticising Congress leader Rahul Gandhi over the 'distribution of wealth' issue, former Karnataka chief minister and BJP leader Basavaraj Bommai on Wednesday told the Wayanad MP to first distribute his 'benami' wealth.

Arvind Kejriwal administered insulin in Tihar: AAP **PARVESH HANDA**

NEW DELHI: Incarcerated Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal was given insulin in Tihar jail for the first time after ED arrest, AAP leaders said on Tuesday.

"Kejriwal's sugar level was continuously getting high and his sugar had gone up to 320, " claimed AAP sources. However, the Tihar jail administration is vet to comment on it.

Meanwhile, the AAP leader took to X and shared information regarding the insulin given to Kejriwal, who is lodged in Jail no 2, in the alleged excise scam. "Good news on Hanuman Jayanti. News is coming that finally the jail administration gave insulin to the Chief Minister for his increasing sugar level. Today, the Chief Minister of the country's capital has to go



to court even for insulin. Officers under the BJP and the Central government say that all prisoners are the same. Delhi AAP Minister Saurabh Bharadwaj wrote on X.

Surat's election exposes flaws in Indian democracy

n a recent and alarming development in Surat, the essence of Indian democracy has been challenged, striking a discordant note that reverberates with concerns about the future of political discourse in the nation. The Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) candidate in Surat was elected unopposed to the Lok Sabha, an event that casts a long shadow on the democratic process. While the BJP celebrates this as a triumph, it inadvertently spotlights a grim reality: a democracy devoid of opposition is a democracy in decline. This concerning scenario unfolded when allegations surfaced that the nomination papers of the Congress candidate, Nilesh Kumbhani, were compromised with forged signatures. Further complicating matters, Suresh Padsala, the dummy candidate for Congress, faced the rejection of his papers under similar dubious circumstances, culminating in the withdrawal of eight other candidates. This cascade of withdrawals left Mukesh Dalal, the BJP candidate, as the sole contender, leading to his uncontested victory declared on April 22. The absence of a contest in Surat raises significant questions about the integrity of the electoral process and the use of state mechanisms to stifle opposition. Such tactics, marked by manipulation and misinformation, not only undermine the electoral system but also erode the foundational democratic principle of fair and free competition. The BJP's vision of a "Congress-less India" might resonate with its strategy of political dominance, but it harbors an authoritarian undertone that is antithetical to democratic values. Moreover, the broader implications of these events are disconcerting. Earlier this year, a similar incident occurred in the Chandigarh mayoral election, where an election officer tampered with results, a decision later overturned by the Supreme Court. These episodes collectively paint a troubling picture of the current state of Indian politics, where electoral victories are increasingly seen as paramount, irrespective of the means to achieve them.

The Swachh Bharat Mission's reality

ndia was ranked right at the bottom of 180 countries in the Environment Performance Index (EPI) in 2022. The EPI ranks countries on climate change performance, environmental health, and ecosystem vitality. It measures 40 performance indicators across 11 issue categories, such as air quality, and drinking water and sanitation. The government responded to the rank saying the methodology is faulty and does not quantify the Indian scenario objectively. For 10 years, the Modi government has embarked on much-hyped campaigns of development. These included the Swachh Bharat Mission, the Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation, the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana, and the National Clean Air Programme.

Is the EPI linked to these missions? It should be, because these missions aim to enable better living standards. The SBM is meant to address the issue of WASH (Water, Sanitation, and Health). Likewise, the SCM is supposed to deliver on the clean energy requirements of towns. However, what we have seen is an increase in the vulnerability of the population owing to air and water pollution, among others.

The Swachh Bharat Mission

So, what went wrong? Let us take the example of the SBM and SBM 2.0, which was launched in 2021 and which aims to make all cities free of garbage. Sanitation and waste management in India are associated with the wide prevalence of caste. Historically, the subjugated castes have been forced to carry out sanitation work. The SBM tried to create a narrative that sanitation is everyone's job. Instead, it has ended up continuing the same old caste practices.

The SBM is a politically successful project; no Opposition party or community has raised objections to it. While the entire



project is governed and monitored by state agencies, the design makes it clear that large capital-intensive technologies are promoted

The Union government claims that India is open defecation-free, but the reality is different. A Comptroller and Auditor General report in 2020 raised many questions about the government's claims over the success of the SBM on this front. It indicated the poor quality of construction of toilets under this scheme. A few urbanisation studies pointed out that in some metros, communities in slums still do not have access to public toilets. Even in rural India, toilet construction has not been linked to waste treatment. In periurban areas, the faecal sludge generated is tossed into the environment. Septic tanks are cleaned by manual scavengers and the sludge is thrown into various water systems

One thing the government intended to do via SBM was to reduce the involvement of people in waste management by replacing them with large, capital-intensive technologies. However, these installations have refused to live up to their promoters' promises, leaving town after town screaming for resources to fix them and, importantly, respond to the health crises emerging from badly managed waste (if at all) as well as the rates and forms of urbanisation local governments believed these technologies would support. In this scenario, the governments outsourced most of the work to private players, who employed the same subjugated communities to handle waste.

Take, for example, solid and liquid waste management in cities. In most towns, the Union government is employing technological solutions in handling solid waste. Some of these solutions are in the form of waste-to-energy plants and biological methanation. But there are barely any success stories in either case.

City governments are being asked to buy more machines including road sweeping machines that cost no less than Rs 1 crore, more vehicles to transport the waste from one corner to another with geo-tagging.

and so on. Funds are made available to the city governments for such plans. However, all this work is being handed over to large contractors entering the city domains for making sanitation a profit entity. Most of the workers employed by these contractors are Dalits. Hence, a scheme fully owned by the state has become a toolkit for the privatisation of public health services and continues caste discrimination.

On March 30, 2024, in the Himachal Pradesh High Court, the Urban Development Department said that there are just five sanitation inspectors in the Shimla Municipal Corporation, which comprises 34 wards. Instead of recruiting more such inspectors, this cadre is being declared dead after they retire. In a State where there are more than 50 municipal bodies, there are only 20 sanitation inspectors, which means that there are some municipalities that have no sanitation inspectors.

There are similar problems with other rogrammes too. Such failures have been dragging down India's EPI performance.

The EPI may be quite comprehensive. However, one of its features of mapping exposes the unsustainability of our development processes. This means that or development models must be altered. The EPI must also be seen in the background of a recent judgment where the Supreme Court observed the links between climate change and basic human rights. Climate scientists have said that the reasons for the current problems are anthropogenic and systemic in nature.

MEGHNA SHARMA SAYS CONGRESS, CPI(M) MANIFESTOS OFFER HOPEFUL SHIFT IN DISABILITY RIGHTS DIALOGUE A glimmer of hope in political arena for disability rights

e release of manifestos during election season rarely occasions a discussion on the rights of persons with disabilities. However, the promise of the Congress and CPI(M) to include disability as a specific ground for discrimination under Article 15 (and Article 16) of the Constitution has sparked optimism within the disability rights movement. Currently, the provision prohibits discrimination on grounds of "religion, race, caste, sex, place of birth, or any of them" and does not expressly include disability.

A constitutional amendment of Article 15 to address this glaring omission has been a long-standing demand of the disability rights movement. In 2019, this demand was reaffirmed by the UN Committee on the Rights s with Disabilities in its con observations while reviewing India's compliance with the UN Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (UNCRPD). To this date, no steps have been taken in this direction. Ever since the Constituent Assembly debates, the discourse on disability rights within the constitutional scheme has continued to overlook the concerns of the disability rights movement. However, the disability rights movement in India and across the globe has made significant strides since then. The adoption of the UNCRPD in 2006 marked a significant step, recognising that persons with disabilities are entitled to enjoy their rights "on an equal basis with others". India ratified the Convention in 2007 and enacted the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act in 2016. While no amendment was made to Article 15 in response to the ratification, Section 3 of the Act provided that no person with disabilities shall be discriminated against on grounds of disability. However, the law only extends a

restricted notion of equality to persons with a departure from colonial rule to adopting

ing disability as an analogous ground may extend the protection of Article 15 to persons with disabilities, it cannot be considered an alternative to a constitutional amendment that specifically includes disability as a ground under Article 15.

The analogous grounds approach poses a burden on the litigator to have the same recognised through the process of constitutional litigation and ignores the systemic marginalisation faced by persons with disabilities. It should be the responsibility of the government and not that of the judiciary to recognise this omission. The possibility of political will he promises made in manifestos of the Congress and the CPI(M) have signalled an era where there is a clear political will to act on the demands of the disability rights Disability rights organ India deserve due credit for their consistent and aggressive advocacy behind this demand. In February 2024, the National Centre for Promotion of Employment for Disabled People (NCPEDP) and the National Disability Network (NDN) launched a first-of-its-kind initiative by releasing a manifesto for and by persons with disabilities, which urged the political parties to prioritise and address the issues of the disabled community. It is only hoped that other parties follow the example. Electoral promises are rarely followed in India's electoral democracy. But despite that, these promises give hope that the movement will no longer face political apathy with regard to this demand and that India is ready to shift the Overton window on this topic.

RBI flags adverse weather, geopolitical tensions as Inflation Risks

IUMBAI: The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has warned that adverse weather conditions and extended geopolitical conflicts leading to volatile crude oil prices may pose a threat to inflation in the near term.

In its monthly bulletin, the RBI stated that consumer price index (CPI) inflation moderated to 4.9 per cent in March after averaging 5.1 per cent in the preceding two months. However, food inflation remains elevated, posing a risk to the disinflation trajectory.

The central bank highlighted that careful monitoring during the summer is warranted as overlapping food price shocks play

New FEMA regulations pave way for Indian Company Listings on Global Stock Exchanges



NEW DELHI: The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has unveiled new regulations under the Foreign Exchange Management Act (FEMA), facilitating the listing of Indian companies on international stock exchanges. These regulations are seen

as a significant step in enabling companies to utilise foreign exchange more effectively and expand their global presence.

The first set of regulations addresses the mode of payment and reporting for non-debt instruments. According to the notification, the proceeds from the purchase or subscription of equity shares of an Indian company listed on an international exchange shall either be remitted to a bank account in India or deposited in a foreign currency account of the Indian company.

Additionally, the sale proceeds (net of taxes) of the equity shares can be remitted outside India or credited to the bank account of the permissible holder.

The investee Indian company, through an authorised dealer, will be responsible for reporting transactions involving foreign exchange





Govt Considers Further Liberalising FDI Norms in **Banking, Insurance & Defence**



NEW DELHI: The Indian government is exploring the possibility of further liberalising foreign direct investment (FDI) norms in crucial sectors such as banking, insurance, and defence. This move comes after the recent relaxation of FDI rules for the space and satellite industries.

According to officials, while the bulk of FDI reforms have already been implemented, discussions are ongoing to assess if the conditions for these key sectors can be further eased.

However, any changes to the existing norms will be undertaken after the conclusion of the ongoing elections on June 1.

"Some areas in finance and insurance, even in defence, could still be looked at in terms of further reduction. Brainstorming is going on, but it has not reached anywhere," said an official familiar with the deliberations. A final decision will be taken after consultations among officials and stakeholders. The government's stance is that India should further relax FDI rules, as the country's current policy is more liberal than that of some other nations, officials noted. "We are more liberal than most of the ASEAN countries, which are generally considered very

open," the official added. Currently, India allows 74 per cent FDI in private sector banking, with up to 49 per cent permitted through the automatic route and government approval needed beyond that. In public sector banking, the FDI cap is fixed at 20 per cent through the government route.

For the insurance sector, India permits 49 per cent FDI in insurance companies through the automatic route and 100 per cent in insurance intermediaries, subject to certain conditions. In the defence industry, FDI can go up to 100 per cent in the manufacture of small arms and ammunition under the Arms Act, with up to 74 per cent permitted through the automatic route, subject to conditions.

Robust demand driving India's Business activity to 14-year high: HSBC report

NEWDELHI: India's business activity expanded at the fastest pace in nearly 14 years this month, driven by robust demand, according to an HSBC survey released on Tuesday. The survey also showed eas-ing input inflation and positive job growth, suggesting that

India is well-positioned to remain the fastest-growing major economy this year. HSBC's flash India Com-

posite Purchasing Managers' Index (PMI), compiled by S&P Global, rose to 62.2 this month from March's final reading of 61.8.

ED attaches properties valued over Rs 55 cr in VMC Systems bank fraud case

NEW DELHI: The Enforcement Directorate (ED) in Hyderabad has provisionally attached movable and immovable properties to the tune of Rs 55.73 crore in a bank fraud case connected to VMC Systems Limited under the provisions of the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA).

The financial probe agency had initiated an investigation based on an FIR registered by the CBI in Bengaluru under various sections of the Indian Penal Code (IPC) against VMC Systems Limited, its directors, and others for defrauding the Punjab National Bank (PNB) and others to the tune of Rs 539.67 crore.

"The probe revealed that in 2009, VMC Systems approached the PNB and the State Bank of India (SBI) for part financing its working capital requirements.

Thereafter, between 2009 and 2012, VMC Systems availed credit facilities from a consortium of banks consisting of Corporation Bank, Andhra Bank, PNB, and Karur Vysya Bank with SBI as the lead bank, to the tune of Rs 1673.52 crore (principal amount), " the ED said in a statement issued on Tuesday.



South Korea are preparing for a fresh round of negotiations in May-June to upgrade their Comprehensive Economic Partnership Agreement (CEPA). This move comes after the conclusion of the 10th round of negotiations earlier this year.

The primary objective for India in these talks is to address the significant trade imbalance that currently favours South Korea, reported Mint.

In the calendar year 2023, India's exports to South Korea stood at USD 6.286 billion,

a decrease of 16.61 per cent nually, according to data from annually, while imports from the Southeast Asian nation Industries were USD 21.361 billion, an increase of 3.19 per cent an-

the Ministry of Commerce and To rectify this trade deficit, India is seeking greater market access for its commodities like rice, steel, and shrimp, as well as improved opportunities in sectors such as healthcare and information technology (IT).

Authorities familiar with the matter have confirmed that the Indian government has raised concerns about the growing trade imbalance between the two countries.

They expressed optimism that the upcoming CEPA negotiations will address and resolve some of these issues, paving the way for a more balanced trade relationship.

WASHINGTON: Workers at Volkswagen's Chattanooga plant in the US state of Tennessee have voted overwhelmingly to unionise at the third attempt, the company and the United Auto Workers (UAW) have announced

The ballot, which ended on Friday, saw 73 per cent of the workers backing the move. The result has yet to be confirmed by the National Labor Relations Board, an agency of the United States federal government.

The UAW, which is seeking to expand its presence in the US automotive sector, sees the outcome as a significant victory.

Two attempts to unionise the plant over recent years failed. But the union has scored major successes recently. In the autumn, it secured better conditions and a pay rise of around 25 per cent at the main US automotive companies, General Motors, Ford and Stellantis (formerly Chrylser), following a lengthy strike. Until now, the union has had little success in the southern states and the plants history."


